178	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
179	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
180	Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%)
181	whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.

182	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
183	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
184	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
185	Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008
186	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
187	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the
188	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
189	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
190	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
191	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
192	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
193	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
194	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal
195	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
196	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
197	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
198	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
199	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services"
200	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
201	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
202	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
203	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
204	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
205	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
206	allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
207	Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
208	approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
209	Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
210	approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
211	without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
212	appropriated level.

213	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
214	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
215	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
216	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
217	The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise
218	award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,
219	realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other
220	means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless
221	specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of
222	teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the
223	next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an
224	educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public
225	Accountant License or higher level professional certification as
226	determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement
227	of a departing employee with an individual from within state
228	service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the
229	departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses,
230	pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be
231	determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise
232	authorized in this act.
233	It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive
234	Director of the Department of Rehabilitation Services may transfer
235	between the various offices authorized herein both funds and
236	positions not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the receiving
237	office in addition to any other transfers or escalations made in
238	accordance with Section 27-104-17(3), Mississippi Code of 1972,
239	Annotated. The Executive Director of the Department of
240	Rehabilitation Services shall submit written justification for the
241	transfer to the Legislative Budget Office and the Department of
242	Finance and Administration on or before the fifteenth of the month
243	prior to the effective date of the transfer. It is further the
244	intention of the Legislature that any transfers made under the

Z 4 5	provisions of this paragraph shall be of an emergency hature and
246	that in no case shall the transfers be made which substantially
247	alter the legislative intent for the various offices as set forth
248	in the original appropriations made under this act.
249	SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums herein
250	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
251	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds which are
252	received by or otherwise become available to the Mississippi
253	Department of Rehabilitation Services to provide funding for
254	construction grants and establishment grants for the fiscal year
255	beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
256	\$ 4,000,000.00.
257	SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
258	Department of Rehabilitation Services shall maintain complete
259	accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
260	funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
261	in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
262	Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
263	the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be
264	submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
265	and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
266	provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.
267	SECTION 7. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or
268	other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of
269	any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of
270	Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for
271	any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of
272	Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.
273	It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles
274	authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply
275	with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972.

- SECTION 8. Of the funds in Sections 1, 2 and 3, the 276 277 Mississippi Department of Rehabilitation Services through the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation for the Blind is authorized to 278 279 expend an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars 280 (\$100,000.00) for the National Federation for the Blind (NFB) News 281 line service to allow blind and visually impaired persons to 282 access newspapers through toll-free telephone calls. 283 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that 284 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 285 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
 made without competitive bids.

 SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated herein, the following

 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

 SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2007.

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
