16	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
17	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
18	Treasury to the credit of the Medical Care Fund created by Section
19	43-13-143, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of providing
20	medical assistance under the Mississippi Medicaid Law for the
21	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
22	\$ 290,875,942.00.
23	SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
24	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special
25	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Governor's Office

26	- Division of Medicaid which is comprised of special source funds
27	collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for the
28	purpose of providing medical assistance under the Mississippi
29	Medicaid Law and defraying the expenses of the administration of
30	such law, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending
31	June 30, 2008 \$ 3,393,503,065.00.
32	Prior period recovery of funds may be maintained and expended
33	by the division when the recovery is received or finalized.
34	SECTION 4. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
35	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
36	Treasury to the credit of the Health Care Expendable Fund, for the
37	purpose of defraying the expenses of the Governor's Office -
38	Division of Medicaid for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007,
39	and ending June 30, 2008\$ 95,743,220.00.
40	The above funds shall be allocated as follows:

Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 90 91 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 92 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 93 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 94 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 95 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal 96 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 97 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 98 99 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 100 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 101 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 102 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 103 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 104 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 105 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 106 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 107 108 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 109 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 110 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 111 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 112 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 113 appropriated level. 114 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 115 116 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 117 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 118 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 119 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,

realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other

means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless

138	in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal	
139	Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that	
140	the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be	
141	submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format	
142	and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail	1
143	provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.	
144	SECTION 7. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance	е
145	Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of	
146	the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilize	d
147	in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve	the
148	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authoriz	ed,

162	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the	
163	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things	
164	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,	
165	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind	
166	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given t	0
167	the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are	
168	made without competitive bids.	
169	SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1, 2, 3 and	d
170	4, an additional amount not less than Two Hundred Fifty Thousand	
171	Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be expended in the Home and Community	
172	Based Waiver Program over and above the amount expended in Fiscal	
173	Year 2007.	
174	SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the	
175	Executive Director of the Division of Medicaid may authorize	
176	increases in any major objects of expenditures in total amounts	
177	not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amoun	t
178	of each major object of expenditure, provided that other major	
179	objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar	
180	amount. It is further the intention of the Legislature that any	
181	transfers made under the provision of this paragraph shall be of	
182	an emergency nature and that in no case shall the transfers be	
183	made which substantially alter the legislative intent for the	
184	various programs as set forth in the original appropriations made	

under this act. However, no transfers shall be authorized which

- increase the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."
- 188 **SECTION 11.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 189 of Section 2, One Hundred Twenty-eight Million Nine Hundred
- 190 Thousand Dollars (\$128,900,000.00) shall be derived from the
- 191 Working Cash-Stabilization Reserve Fund for the purpose of
- 192 providing medical assistance under the Mississippi Medicaid law.
- 193 **SECTION 12.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 194 of Section 2, Twenty-nine Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 195 (\$29,400,000.00) shall be derived from the Budget Contingency
- 196 Fund, as created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972,
- 197 for the purpose of matching available federal funds.
- 198 **SECTION 13.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 199 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 200 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 201 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 202 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 203 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 204 **SECTION 14.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 205 and after July 1, 2007.
