Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and
9	maintenance of the State Forestry Commission for the fiscal year
10	beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
11	\$ 19,489,615.00.
12	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
13	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
14	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Forestry
15	Commission which is comprised of special source funds collected by
16	or otherwise available to the commission, for the support and
17	maintenance of the commission for the fiscal year beginning
18	July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
19	\$ 10,239,093.00.
20	Of the funds specified in this section, Two Hundred Fifty
21	Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be deposited in a fund
22	created in the State Treasury called the "Forest Improvement
23	Revolving Fund." Money in this fund shall be used by the State
24	Forestry Commission to assist in the reforestation and growth

- 25 improvement of the forests, woodlands, and publicly owned lands of
- 26 the state, including sixteenth section lands, Camp Shelby,
- 27 Columbia Training School and colleges and universities.
- 28 Landowners who contract with the commission for such work shall
- 29 pay to the commission its actual cost for conducting such work.
- 30 Money received for this work by the commission shall be paid into
- 31 the State Treasury, and the State Treasurer shall deposit such
- 32 money in the "Forest Improvement Revolving Fund."
- 33 **SECTION 3.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 34 Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:

94	determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise
95	authorized in this act.
96	SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
97	State Forestry Commission and the Mississippi Institute for Forest
98	Inventory shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records
99	related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this
100	act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of
101	detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the
102	intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for
103	Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative
104	Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the
105	format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008
106	budget request process.
107	SECTION 5. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
108	Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
109	the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
110	in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
111	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,
112	this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted
113	performance measures provided below:

146	collected by or otherwise available to the Institute for	the
147	purpose of defraying the expenses of the Institute for t	he period

214	SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
215	State Forestry Commission be allowed to escalate its budget in the

Capital Outlay: Equipment major object of expenditure, with funds

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generated from the Forest Acreage Tax, and with funds generated 217 218 from the sale of old equipment and lease of tower sites an amount 219 not to exceed Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00). 220 It is further the intention of the Legislature that the State 221 Forestry Commission be allowed to escalate its budget in the 222 Subsidies, Loans and Grants major object of expenditure, with 223 funds generated from the Severance Tax to fund the Forest Resource 224 Development Program in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred 225 Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00). The receipt of these funds is 226 hereby authorized and approved, provided such receipts and 227 expenditures are reported and otherwise accounted for in 228 accordance with Section 27-103-101 et seq. and Section 27-104-1 et 229 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 230 State Forestry Commission be allowed to escalate part-time 231 232 positions up to one hundred (100) and expend funds not to exceed 233 Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) from any source of funds that become available to the commission. This escalation 234 235 shall be in accordance with rules and regulations of the 236 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. These positions may be used 237 238 to protect life and property during extended periods of extreme 239 wildfire occurrences of a minimum of fifty (50) fires per day. 240 The escalation of positions and the expenditure of these funds 241 shall be at the discretion of the State Forester, with written 242 notification to the State Personnel Board and the State Fiscal 243 Officer. 244 **SECTION 11.** The Forestry Commission has the authority to purchase from the "General Services Administration" Fire Fighter 245 246 Catalog and any other GSA Catalog as long as the cost of such

items are less than the quotes received.

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248	SECTION 12. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
249	fund designated as the Volunteer Fire Department Equipment
250	Conversion Revolving Fund to be used by the State Forestry
251	Commission to assist in the conversion of vehicles acquired by the
252	State Forestry Commission through the Federal Excess Personal
253	Property Program or by Volunteer Fire Departments through other
254	means to adapt them for use in the suppression of wildland fires.
255	This assistance shall be in the form of fabrication of water tanks
256	or other accessories necessary for the operation of fire
257	suppression units, installation of piping and valves, painting or
258	other similar or associated component work necessary to place fire
259	suppression equipment into service. It is not for general vehicle
260	maintenance or repair.
261	The Volunteer Fire Department Equipment Conversion Revolving
262	Fund shall be funded by monies received from charges for work and
263	services performed for Volunteer Fire Departments by the State
264	Forestry Commission. Monies collected from such charges shall be
265	deposited into the Volunteer Fire Department Equipment Conversion
266	Revolving Fund. The State Treasurer shall make disbursements
267	therefrom for payment of materials, supplies and labor upon
268	requisition of the Forestry Commission and upon the issuance of
269	warrants therefor by the Department of Finance and Administration.
270	The amount of monies deposited into the Volunteer Fire
271	Department Equipment Conversion Fund through this work shall not
272	exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00). Funds in excess of
273	Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be placed in the State
274	Forestry Commission's regular appropriated special funds. Monies
275	in this revolving fund are to be considered special funds and
276	shall be carried forward from one fiscal year to the next.
277	SECTION 13. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
278	fund designated as the Camden State Forest Revolving Fund to be
279	used by the State Forestry Commission to direct forest management

- 280 activities on the Camden State Forest in Madison County,
- 281 Mississippi. The forest management activities will include, but
- 282 not be limited to, maintenance of property, timber sale activities
- 283 and regeneration work.
- The Camden State Forest Revolving Fund shall be funded by
- 285 monies received from timber sales, leases, and any other source.
- 286 Monies collected from these income sources shall be deposited into
- 287 the Camden State Forest Revolving Fund. The State Treasurer shall
- 288 make disbursements therefrom for payments of materials, supplies
- 289 and labor upon requisition of the State Forestry Commission and
- 290 upon the issuance of warrants therefor by the Department of
- 291 Finance and Administration.
- 292 It is the intention of the Legislature that any revolving
- 293 funds in excess of the budgeted amount needed for the necessary
- 294 operation and maintenance of all properties under the direct
- 295 supervision and management of the State Forestry Commission shall
- 296 remain in the Camden State Forest Revolving Fund for use in future
- 297 years.
- 298 **SECTION 14.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 and
- 299 authorized for expenditure in Section 3, it is the intention of
- 300 the Legislature that Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00)
- 301 shall be transferred to the Department of Agriculture and Commerce
- 302 for the Beaver Control or Eradication Program during the Fiscal
- 303 Year 2007.
- 304 **SECTION 15.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 305 Mississippi Institute for Forest Inventory is hereby authorized to
- 306 accept, budget and expend funds, not to exceed One Million Dollars
- 307 (\$1,000,000.00), from any source in accordance with rules and
- 308 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a
- 309 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.
- 310 **SECTION 16.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 311 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the

312	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
313	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
314	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
315	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
316	the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are

made without competitive bids.

- 318 **SECTION 17.** Any person who was an employee of the Forestry
 319 Commission who was laid off during Fiscal Year 2006 shall be given
 320 first priority in any new employment by the commission.
- 321 **SECTION 18.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
 322 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
 323 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
 324 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
 325 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
 326 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 327 **SECTION 19.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 328 and after July 1, 2007.

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
