L8	the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the
L9	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008

47	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
48	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
49	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
50	Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%)
51	whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.
52	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
53	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
54	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal

- Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 55
- funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 56
- 57 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the
- 58 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
- 59 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
- 60 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
- 61 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
- It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 62
- that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 63
- 64 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal
- Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 65
- 66 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 67
- has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 68
- projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 69
- 70 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 71 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 72
- 73 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- 74 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 75 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 76
- 77 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 78 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.
- 79 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 80 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 81 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- appropriated level. 82
- 83 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 84 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 85
- 86 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

87 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 88 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, 89 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other 90 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 91 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of 92 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 93 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 94 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 95 96 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 97 of a departing employee with an individual from within state 98 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, 99 100 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 101 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 102 authorized in this act. 103 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 104 State Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall maintain 105 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 106 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 107 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of 108 109 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 110 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 111 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request 112 113 process. SECTION 5. The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission 114 115 is hereby authorized to retain all funds generated from the sale 116 of equipment. Any funds made available from the sale of equipment

shall be deposited into the special fund in the State Treasury to

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- 118 the credit of the Soil and Water Conservation Commission and shall
- 119 be used solely for the purpose of purchasing equipment.
- 120 **SECTION 6.** The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission
- 121 is hereby authorized to receive, budget and expend any proceeds
- 122 derived from the sale of bonds authorized in Section 69-27-331 et
- 123 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. All expenditures shall be in
- 124 accordance with conditions provided in Section 69-27-331 et seq.,
- 125 Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 126 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 127 Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall have the authority to
- 128 escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed
- 129 Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) in accordance
- 130 with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
- 131 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
- 132 federal funds.
- 133 **SECTION 8.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, it is the
- 134 intention of the Legislature that an amount not to exceed
- 135 Sixty-five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000.00) be used for the purpose
- 136 of funding a Beaver Control Cost Share program. The Mississippi
- 137 Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall promulgate rules and
- 138 regulations for the establishment and operation of the program on
- 139 a fund matching basis with the county unit of government. Funds
- 140 not expended or encumbered in a county may be transferred to
- 141 another county during the fiscal year. Only those funds
- 142 specifically appropriated for the Beaver Control Cost Share
- 143 program shall be used in any such program.
- 144 **SECTION 9.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 145 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 146 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 147 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 148 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 149 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

- the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids.
- section 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 158 **SECTION 11.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 159 and after July 1, 2007.
