AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO**

1 **AMEND by inserting the following after line 855 and renumber**
2 **subsequent section(s) accordingly:**

3 **SECTION *.** Section 27-19-44, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
4 amended as follows:

5 27-19-44. (1) For any distinctive license tag or plate
6 authorized by the Legislature from and after July 1, 2000, through
7 June 30, 2002, or authorized by Sections 27-19-56.37 and
8 27-19-56.55, the requirements of this subsection must be met
9 before the State Tax Commission may prepare or issue any such
10 license tag or plate. The organization or other entity for which
11 the Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or plate
12 must submit proof satisfactory to the State Tax Commission that at
13 least one hundred (100) of such license tags or plates will be
14 purchased and must deposit with the commission an amount necessary
15 to purchase one hundred (100) of such license tags or plates. The
16 organization or other entity for which the Legislature authorized
17 the distinctive license tag or plate must satisfy the requirements
18 of this subsection (1) within two (2) years after the effective
19 date of the law authorizing the license tag or plate in order to
20 permit the license tag or plate to be prepared and issued.

21 (2) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (1) of this
22 section, any distinctive license tag or plate authorized by the
23 Legislature from and after July 1, 2002, through June 30, 2007,

24 the requirements of this subsection must be met before the State
25 Tax Commission may prepare or issue any such license tag or plate.
26 The organization or other entity for which the Legislature
27 authorized the distinctive license tag or plate must submit proof
28 satisfactory to the State Tax Commission that at least two hundred
29 (200) of such license tags or plates will be purchased and must
30 deposit with the commission an amount necessary to purchase two
31 hundred (200) of such license tags or plates. The organization or
32 other entity for which the Legislature authorized the distinctive
33 license tag or plate must satisfy the requirements of this
34 subsection (2) within three (3) years after the effective date of
35 the law authorizing the license tag or plate in order to permit
36 the license tag or plate to be prepared and issued.

37 (3) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (1) of this
38 section, any distinctive license tag or plate authorized by the
39 Legislature from and after July 1, 2007, the requirements of this
40 subsection must be met before the State Tax Commission may prepare
41 or issue any such license tag or plate. The organization or other
42 entity for which the Legislature authorized the distinctive
43 license tag or plate must submit proof satisfactory to the State
44 Tax Commission that at least three hundred (300) of such license
45 tags or plates will be purchased and must deposit with the
46 commission an amount necessary to purchase three hundred (300) of
47 such license tags or plates. The organization or other entity for
48 which the Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or
49 plate must satisfy the requirements of this subsection (3) within
50 three (3) years after the effective date of the law authorizing
51 the license tag or plate in order to permit the license tag or
52 plate to be prepared and issued.

53 (4) If the organization or other entity for which the
54 Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or plate meets
55 the requirements of subsection (1), (2) or (3) of this section,

56 the State Tax Commission shall prepare and issue the distinctive
57 license tag or plate.

58 (5) The State Tax Commission shall review the number of
59 distinctive or special license tags or plates issued pursuant to
60 this chapter during the period for the license tag or plate
61 series. If the number of any distinctive or special license tag
62 or plate issued pursuant to this chapter falls below one hundred
63 (100) in the last year of the license tag or plate series, the
64 distinctive or special license tag or plate shall be discontinued
65 at the end of the period for the license tag or plate series.

66 (6) If a distinctive or special license tag or plate is
67 discontinued under subsection (5) of this section, the
68 organization or other entity for which the license tag or plate
69 was discontinued may prepare a distinctive or special license tag
70 or plate decal. The distinctive or special license tag or plate
71 decal shall be of such size, color and design as may be agreed
72 upon by the organization or other entity and the State Tax
73 Commission. However, the State Tax Commission shall have final
74 approval of the size, color and design of the decal. The
75 distinctive or special license tag or plate decals shall be
76 prepared and sold by the organization or other entity, and the
77 proceeds derived from the sale of such decals shall be retained by
78 the organization or other entity for any use deemed appropriate by
79 the organization or other entity.

80 (7) The provisions of this section shall not apply to
81 distinctive or special license tags or plates:

82 (a) Which are issued under Section 27-19-45, 27-19-46,
83 27-19-47.1, 27-19-47.2, 27-19-48, 27-19-49, 27-19-53, 27-19-55,
84 27-19-56, 27-19-56.1, 27-19-56.2, 27-19-56.3, 27-19-56.5,
85 27-19-56.6, 27-19-56.9, 27-19-56.11, 27-19-56.12, 27-19-56.13,
86 27-19-56.62, 27-19-56.69, 27-19-56.79 or 27-19-56.137; or

87 (b) For which no additional fee is required to be paid.
