TO THE MISSISSIPPI STATE SENATE:

GOVERNOR'S VETO MESSAGE FOR SENATE BILL 2562

I am returning Senate Bill Number 2562: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-26-101, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO EXEMPT FROM MANAGEMENT TRAINING REQUIREMENTS THE BOARD MEMBERS OF COMMUNITY PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS OPERATED BY MUNICIPALITIES WITH A POPULATION GREATER THAN 10,000; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES." without my approval, and assign the following reasons for my veto.

On March 15, 2007, I signed into law House Bill 1227, which is identical to Senate Bill 2562 and accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, there is no need for Senate Bill 2562.
