HOUSE BILL NO. 1108 (As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT TO CREATE SECTION 97-9-116, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO INCLUDE BRIBING A JUDGE IN OFFENSES AFFECTING JUSTICE; AND FOR 3 RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
97-9-116, Mississippi Code of 1972:

7 <u>97-9-116.</u> (1) A person commits the crime of bribing a judge 8 if he intentionally or knowingly offers, confers or agrees to 9 confer any benefit upon a judge with the intent that the judge's 10 decision, vote, recommendation or other exercise of official 11 discretion in a judicial or administrative proceeding will thereby 12 be influenced.

13 (2) Bribing a judge is a <u>felony punishable by imprisonment</u>
14 <u>for not less than five (5) years nor more than twenty (20) years</u>
15 <u>and by a fine three (3) times the amount of the bribe but in no</u>
16 <u>case less than Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00).</u>
17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

18 and after July 1, 2008.
