HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 32

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING CONGRESS TO ENFORCE EXISTING
2 FEDERAL IMMIGRATION LAWS.

3 WHEREAS, over the past decade, the United States has seen a
4 huge influx of illegal immigrants into this great country; and

5 WHEREAS, federal immigration laws exist to prohibit illegal
6 immigrants from receiving federal and state benefits and from
7 working in the United States without gaining United States'
8 citizenship for themselves or their families; and

9 WHEREAS, the federal government refuses to enforce the
10 existing immigration laws of this great nation, but prefers to
11 turn its head; and

12 WHEREAS, the citizens of Mississippi are losing jobs because
13 of this lack of enforcement; and

14 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to address the
15 issues of our citizens to the federal government:

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
17 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
18 THEREIN, That we urge the United States federal government to
19 enforce existing immigration laws.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be
21 furnished to concerned citizens of Mississippi and to the members
22 of the Capitol Press Corps.
