## HOUSE BILL NO. 659

- AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO CONDUCT
  ONE OR MORE PILOT PROGRAMS BANNING SMOKING AT STATE CORRECTIONAL

  ON THE STATUS OF THE PROGRAMS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Department of Corrections shall conduct 10 one or more pilot programs banning smoking both inside buildings 11 and on the grounds of state correctional facilities and shall
- 13 (2) As used in this section, "tobacco products" means
  14 cigars, cigarettes, snuff, loose tobacco or similar goods made
  15 with any part of the tobacco plant that are prepared or used for
  16 smoking, chewing, dipping or other personal use.

administer smoking cessation programs for staff and inmates.

- 17 (3) The pilot smoking cessation programs shall be available 18 to inmates and staff on a volunteer basis, and no person shall be 19 compelled or coerced to participate.
- 20 (4) The smoking cessation program shall include instructions 21 and education that will help inmates and staff cease the use of 22 tobacco products and remain smoke free.
- 23 (5) The cost of administering the pilot smoking cessation 24 program shall be paid from existing funds available to the 25 Department of Corrections.
- 26 (6) The Department of Corrections may use services,
  27 personnel and resources donated by nongovernmental agencies and
  28 organizations to implement this program.

- 29 (7) The Department of Corrections shall report to both the
- 30 House and Senate Corrections Committees on or before January 15,
- 31 2010, on the progress and status of the pilot programs.
- 32 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 33 and after July 1, 2009.
