## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 96

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO EXTEND THE 2009 REGULAR SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE FOR A PERIOD OF THIRTY DAYS FROM THE FINAL DAY OF THE NINETY-DAY SESSION; TO AUTHORIZE THE HOUSE AND SENATE TO ADJOURN FOR MORE THAN THREE DAYS; TO PROVIDE THAT THE HOUSE AND SENATE SHALL RECONVENE ON MAY 4, 2009, UNLESS THE SPEAKER AND LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR JOINTLY DETERMINE THAT IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO RECONVENE; TO AUTHORIZE THE SPEAKER AND LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR TO RECONVENE THE HOUSE AND SENATE BEFORE MAY 4, 2009; TO EXTEND THE 8 2009 REGULAR SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE FOR ANOTHER PERIOD OF THIRTY DAYS IF THE HOUSE AND SENATE DO NOT RECONVENE ON OR BEFORE 10 MAY 4, 2009; TO PROVIDE THAT THE HOUSE AND SENATE SHALL RECONVENE 11 ON MAY 4, 2009, UNLESS THE SPEAKER AND LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR JOINTLY 12 DETERMINE THAT IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO RECONVENE; TO AUTHORIZE THE 13 SPEAKER AND LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR TO RECONVENE THE HOUSE AND SENATE 14 BEFORE MAY 4, 2009; TO PROVIDE THAT IF THE SESSION IS EXTENDED FOR 15 A SECOND PERIOD OF THIRTY DAYS, THE HOUSE AND SENATE SHALL 16 RECONVENE ON JUNE 1, 2009, UNLESS THE SPEAKER AND LIEUTENANT 17 GOVERNOR JOINTLY DETERMINE THAT IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO RECONVENE; 18 TO AUTHORIZE THE SPEAKER AND LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR TO RECONVENE THE 19 HOUSE AND SENATE BEFORE JUNE 1, 2009; TO SUSPEND THE DEADLINES FOR 20 THE PURPOSE OF PERMITTING THE FURTHER CONSIDERATION, FILING AND 21 22 ADOPTION OF CONFERENCE REPORTS ON APPROPRIATION BILLS; TO SUSPEND THE DEADLINES FOR THE PURPOSE OF REQUESTING THE DRAFTING, AND THE 23 24 INTRODUCTION, CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE, OF A BILL ENTITLED "AN 25 ACT TO AMEND SECTION 5-1-51, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE FINAL ONE-THIRD OF THE SALARY OF MEMBERS OF THE 26 LEGISLATURE FOR THE 2009 REGULAR SESSION SHALL BE PAID ON THE 27 NINETIETH DAY OF THE SESSION; TO AMEND SECTION 5-1-47, MISSISSIPPI 28 CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE SHALL 29 30 RECEIVE THE REGULAR EXPENSE ALLOWANCE AND MILEAGE FOR ATTENDING TO 31 LEGISLATIVE DUTIES ON CERTAIN DAYS THAT THE HOUSE OF 32 REPRESENTATIVES OR THE SENATE DOES NOT CONVENE IN SESSION ON THOSE 33 DAYS, UPON THE APPROVAL OF THE HOUSE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE OR THE 34 SENATE RULES COMMITTEE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES." BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE 35 36 OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN, That the 2009 37 Regular Session of the Legislature is extended for a period of

thirty (30) days from the final day of the ninety (90) calendar

days of the 2009 Regular Session of the Legislature, under the

provisions of Section 36, Mississippi Constitution of 1890.

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives and 41 42 the Senate may stand adjourned for a period of more than three (3) 43 days from any date and time determined by each respective house. 44 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the House and Senate shall 45 reconvene at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, May 4, 2009, unless the Speaker 46 of the House and the Lieutenant Governor jointly determine that it is not necessary to reconvene, in which case the House and Senate 47 shall not reconvene on that date. 48 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if the Speaker of the House and 49 the Lieutenant Governor jointly determine that it is necessary for 50 51 the House and Senate to reconvene before Monday, May 4, 2009, the House and Senate shall reconvene on the date and time jointly 52 53 declared by the Speaker and the Lieutenant Governor. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if the House and Senate do not 54 reconvene on or before Monday, May 4, 2009, the 2009 Regular 55 Session of the Legislature is extended for another period of 56 thirty (30) days from Monday, May 4, 2009, under the provisions of 57 58 Section 36, Mississippi Constitution of 1890. 59 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if the 2009 Regular Session is 60 extended for a second period of thirty (30) days, the House and Senate shall reconvene at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, June 1, 2009, 61 62 unless both the Speaker of the House and the Lieutenant Governor jointly determine that it is not necessary to reconvene, in which 63 case the House and Senate shall not reconvene on that date. 64
- Senate shall reconvene at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, June 1, 2009,
  unless both the Speaker of the House and the Lieutenant Governor
  jointly determine that it is not necessary to reconvene, in which
  case the House and Senate shall not reconvene on that date.

  BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if the 2009 Regular Session is
  extended for a second period of thirty (30) days, and the Speaker
  of the House and the Lieutenant Governor jointly determine that it
  is necessary for the House and Senate to reconvene before Monday,
  June 1, 2009, the House and Senate shall reconvene on the date and
  time jointly declared by the Speaker and the Lieutenant Governor.
