SENATE BILL NO. 2770 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO REQUIRE 1 2 THAT BEGINNING WITH THE 2009-2010 SCHOOL YEAR ANNUAL IN-SERVICE 3 TRAINING FOR PRESENTLY EMPLOYED TEACHERS AND PRINCIPALS SHALL INCLUDE SUICIDE PREVENTION EDUCATION, WITH SUCH TRAINING TO BE 4 DEVELOPED BY THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH; TO 5 6 REOUIRE SUCH TRAINING FOR NEWLY EMPLOYED LICENSED TEACHERS AND PRINCIPALS BEGINNING WITH THE 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR; TO DIRECT THE 7 STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO REQUIRE THAT BEGINNING WITH THE 8 9 2009-2010 SCHOOL YEAR ANNUAL IN-SERVICE TRAINING FOR TEACHERS IN GRADES K-3 SHALL INCLUDE INTENSIVE, COMPREHENSIVE AND 10 RESEARCHED-BASED READING METHODS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 11

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 13 SECTION 1. In the 2009-2010 school year, the State Department of Education shall require that local school districts 14 conduct in-service training on suicide prevention education for 15 16 all licensed teachers and principals. The Mississippi Department 17 of Mental Health will be responsible for development of the content of the training and determining the appropriate amount of 18 19 time that should be allotted for the training. This education may 20 be accomplished through self-review of suitable suicide prevention 21 materials.

SECTION 2. Beginning with the 2010-2011 school year, the 22 State Department of Education shall require that local school 23 24 districts conduct in-service training on suicide prevention 25 education for all newly employed licensed teachers and principals. The Mississippi Department of Mental Health will be responsible 26 27 for development of the content of the training and determining the 28 appropriate amount of time that should be allotted for the 29 training. This education may be accomplished through self-review 30 of suitable suicide prevention materials.

No. 2770 09/SS02/R1167SG PAGE 1 31 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Beginning with the 2009-2010 school year, the 32 State Department of Education shall require that in-service 33 training shall include an emphasis on intensive, comprehensive and 34 researched-based reading methods for all licensed teachers 35 teaching Grades K through 3. The education may be accomplished 36 through self-review of suitable intensive, comprehensive and 37 researched-based reading materials.
