- 6 SECTION 1. (1)Smoking is prohibited by any person in the
- 7 enclosed passenger compartment of a motor vehicle in which a
- 8 person under the age of twenty-one (21) years is a passenger or
- 9 the driver. The passenger compartment shall be considered as
- 10 enclosed even if one or more windows are open. As used in this
- section, the term "smoking" has the meaning as defined in Section 11
- 29-5-161. 12
- 13 Any person violating this section is guilty of a
- misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined not more than 14
- Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or imprisoned in the county jail 15
- for not more than thirty (30) days, or both. 16
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 17
- and after July 1, 2010. 18
