- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** If a business or service establishment that is
- 7 open to the public is located in a county or municipality that
- 8 does not have an ordinance prohibiting smoking, and the
- 9 establishment has a policy prohibiting smoking in the facilities
- 10 of the establishment and has posted prominent signs at the
- 11 entrance of and within the facilities stating that smoking is
- 12 prohibited in those facilities and that violations are punishable
- 13 as a misdemeanor, then any person who violates the posted
- 14 nonsmoking policy of the establishment is guilty of a misdemeanor
- 15 and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than
- 16 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)
- 17 for each such offense.
- 18 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 19 and after July 1, 2010.
