7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
8	SECTION 1. Establishments licensed under the Mississippi
9	Gaming Control Act and licensees under the Charitable Bingo Law
10	may allow smoking by patrons on their licensed premises. The
11	provisions of this section shall supersede any existing or
12	subsequently enacted local law, ordinance or regulation that
13	prohibits or restricts smoking. As used in this section "smoking"
14	means inhaling, exhaling, burning, carrying or otherwise possessing
15	any lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe or any other object or device of
16	any form that contains lighted tobacco or any other smoking product.
17	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2010.
