- 3 CHURCH.
- 4 WHEREAS, Tylertown First Baptist Church was established on
- 5 May 10, 1910. Through its ministry, this leading church in South
- 6 Central Mississippi has empowered thousands of families and other
- 7 individuals at the local, state, national and international
- 8 levels. Tylertown First Baptist Church is celebrating its "100
- 9 Years of Ministry Anniversary Celebration" on May 5-15, 2010; and
- 10 WHEREAS, in 1910, the late George Gutter and his wife,
- 11 Frankey Brumfield-Gutter, along with their two children, Georgia
- 12 and Mamie, came to Tylertown, Mississippi. Gutter's vision for a
- 13 place of worship led him to an old cattle shed, where he removed
- 14 the walls which provided enough material to build 40 to 50 seats.
- 15 Friends who stood with him donated one table, one chair and some
- 16 lamps. Sawdust was used for flooring and kerosene lamps were
- 17 mounted on posts as a source for lighting; and
- 18 WHEREAS, George Gutter started the ministry with those in
- 19 support of the vision. Setting the foundation for a thriving
- 20 church, Reverend Jesse Dillon served as Tylertown First Baptist
- 21 Church's first Pastor, and M.C. Hall-Dean was elected the church's
- 22 first Sunday School Superintendent; and
- 23 WHEREAS, the church was named "Mount Wade Missionary Baptist
- 24 Church." The founder, George Gutter, became the first Deacon.
- 25 Meeting days were held monthly, first Saturdays and Sundays.
- 26 Reverend G.W. Holden became Pastor after the death of Reverend
- 27 Jesse Dillon. Henry Buckles and Robert Varnado were ordained as

- 28 Deacons and the following members were added: M.C. Hall-Dean;
- 29 George Pinn, Sr.; George Pinn, Jr.; Fred Raiford; Rankin Varnado;
- 30 Lula Mae Allen; Pearl B. Williams; and Letha Buckles; and
- 31 WHEREAS, in 1913, the ministry was moved to its present site
- 32 located at 1506 Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive and renamed
- 33 Tylertown First Baptist Church; and
- 34 WHEREAS, Tylertown First Baptist Church has had five Pastors
- 35 over its 100-year blessed history and has long provided
- 36 outstanding ministries, and continues to do so through its current
- 37 Senior Pastor, Bishop Walter J. Smith, its Pastors Clayton Bullock
- 38 and Sherman Smith, and Board of Elders Patrick Lubanga and Alice
- 39 Richmond. Bishop Walter J. Smith has been serving as Senior
- 40 Pastor since January 1, 1982; and
- WHEREAS, in 1995, Pastor Walter J. Smith, a native of
- 42 Tylertown, extended the ministry to International Mission. He
- 43 took the first mission trip to Africa preaching the gospel of
- 44 Jesus Christ to teachers, pastors, families and individuals to
- 45 help them meet their spiritual needs, while helping them to
- 46 increase their faith and rebuild their lives through quality
- 47 training. Under the leadership of Bishop Smith, the ministry is
- 48 being preached globally in areas such as Denmark, Ghana, India,
- 49 Kenya, Malaysia, Philippines, Tanzania, Uganda, United Kingdom
- 50 (UK) and Zanzibar; and
- 51 WHEREAS, in 2005, Walter J. Smith was ordained Bishop under
- 52 the Seal of Bishop Mark J. Chironna, Chief Celebrant and Presiding
- 53 Bishop at the Master's Touch International Church in Orlando,
- 54 Florida; and
- 55 WHEREAS, Bishop Smith is a visionary to encourage all people
- 56 to achieve their God-given potential. He has developed numerous
- 57 projects and organizations in the area in an effort to revitalize
- 58 the City of Tylertown. Under his leadership, the ministry has
- 59 become God's catalyst for change in the region to combat poverty.

60	He is married to Shirley Smith, a native of Brookhaven,
61	Mississippi. They are the parents of John and Gweneka; and
