- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 63-1-73, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 63-1-73. (1) It shall be unlawful for an operator of a
- 11 moving motor vehicle on a public road or highway of this state to
- 12 <u>use a wireless telephone or electronic communication device to</u>
- 13 engage in wireless interactive communication.
- 14 (2) For the purposes of this section, the following terms
- 15 shall have the meanings ascribed to them unless the context
- 16 clearly indicates otherwise:
- 17 (a) "Wireless telephone or electronic communication
- 18 device" means a wireless interactive communication device with
- 19 which a user may engage in a text-based communication using one
- 20 (1) hand or both hands or by reading a text-based communication.
- 21 The term does not include a hands-free wireless telephone or
- 22 <u>electronic communication device</u>, a communication system installed
- 23 in a commercial vehicle weighing greater than ten thousand
- 24 (10,000) pounds, a Citizens' band radio, or a Citizens' band radio
- 25 hybrid.
- 26 (b) "Hands-free wireless telephone or electronic
- 27 communication device" means a wireless telephone or electronic
