HOUSE BILL NO. 636 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-15-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE HOMESCHOOLED STUDENTS TO BE TESTED PRIOR TO TRANSFER INTO A PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR GRADE ASSIGNMENT PURPOSES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-15-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 37-15-33. All students seeking to transfer from any school,
- 9 public, private or homeschool within or outside of the boundaries
- 10 of the State of Mississippi, to a public school within the state
- 11 may be required to take a test to determine the grade and class to
- 12 which the pupil shall be assigned at the time of pupil transfer.
- 13 The administrative head of each public school shall
- 14 administer the test or tests to such pupil or pupils as shall
- 15 apply for transfer to such public school. Such test or tests
- 16 shall be administered within thirty (30) days after the filing of
- 17 each such application for transfer. Notice of the giving of such
- 18 test shall be given the applicant not less than five (5) days
- 19 prior to the date of the administration of such test.
- No transfer of a pupil shall be effected until the test has
- 21 been given and the pupil is assigned according to the grade and
- 22 class for which the test shows he is best suited. No pupil shall
- 23 be assigned to a grade and class more than three (3) grades above
- 24 or below the grade or class that the pupil would have been
- 25 assigned to had the pupil remained in the school from which the
- 26 transfer is being made. Pending the administration of the test
- 27 herein provided for and its grading and an assignment based

- 28 thereon the superintendent of the school district or the
- 29 attendance center principal to which the pupil seeks admission may
- 30 assign the pupil temporarily to a grade and class comparable to
- 31 that in which the pupil would have been had the pupil continued in
- 32 the school from which the transfer was being made.
- If any student is transferred or reassigned within the school
- 34 district by order of the board of trustees of that school district
- 35 as designated by law of the State of Mississippi and not at his
- 36 own request, the requirement of that pupil's taking the
- 37 standardized test shall be waived. Likewise, if a pupil shall
- 38 transfer from one school district to another school district in
- 39 the manner provided and required by the laws of the State of
- 40 Mississippi, the requirement of such pupil taking the standardized
- 41 test shall be waived.
- 42 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 43 and after July 1, 2011.
