HOUSE BILL NO. 770

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-31, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 PROVIDE THAT THE OPEN SEASON ON THE HUNTING OF DEER WITH GUNS AND 3 WITH DOGS ON HOMOCHITTO NATIONAL FOREST LANDS SHALL BE FROM THE FIRST SATURDAY BEFORE THANKSGIVING THROUGH DECEMBER 1; TO PROVIDE 4 THAT ONLY LEGAL BUCKS MAY BE HARVESTED; TO PROHIBIT THE HUNTING OF 5 6 DEER ON HOMOCHITTO NATIONAL FOREST LANDS DURING ANY OTHER OPEN 7 SEASON ESTABLISHED FOR HUNTING WITH GUNS AND WITH DOGS; AND FOR 8 RELATED PURPOSES. 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 49-7-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 10 11 amended as follows: 49-7-31. (1) The open season on deer shall be as follows: 12 13 (a) With bow and arrow: October 1 through the Friday prior to Thanksgiving. 14 With guns and with dogs: from the Saturday prior 15 (b) 16 to Thanksgiving through December 1. With primitive weapons and without dogs: December 17 (C) 2 through December 15. 18 (d) With guns and without dogs: December 16 through 19 December 23. However, the commission may allow hunting statewide 20 21 or in specific areas with any legal weapon which it may designate without dogs after the end of the last season for hunting deer 22 23 with guns and with dogs, but the season with legal designated weapons and without dogs shall not extend beyond January 31. 24 25 The commission shall establish an extended season (e) with primitive weapons and bow and arrow without dogs from 26 February 1 through February 15 for the area south of U.S. Highway 27 84 and east of Mississippi Highway 35 only for legal bucks. Any 28 29 antlered deer taken in this area during any open season under this

30 section must be a legal buck as defined in this paragraph. For 31 purposes of this paragraph, the term "legal buck" means a deer with antlers of four (4) points or more with a minimum inside 32 33 spread of ten (10) inches or a minimum main beam length of 34 thirteen (13) inches. The commission may regulate the taking of 35 deer with antlers of four (4) points or less under this paragraph for the proper management of antlered deer. The commission may 36 37 delay the opening date and change the length of bow and arrow 38 season in subsection (1)(a) in this area.

39 (f) With guns and with dogs: December 24 through a 40 date fixed by the commission that will provide a total of 41 thirty-nine (39) days of hunting deer with guns and with dogs when 42 added to the number of days provided for hunting deer with guns 43 and with dogs in paragraph (b), except that hunting deer on 44 <u>Homochitto National Forest lands during this season is prohibited</u>.

45 (g) With regard to the hunting of deer on Homochitto
46 National Forest lands, the open season on deer, with guns and with
47 dogs, shall be from the Saturday before Thanksgiving through
48 December 1 only. Only antlered deer that meet the requirements of
49 a legal buck, as defined in paragraph (e) of this subsection,

50 <u>shall be taken in this area during the season established by for</u> 51 hunting on Homochitto <u>National Forest lands.</u>

52 (2) The commission may set and regulate the deer seasons on 53 wildlife management areas which it administers.

(3) (a) The commission may allow the harvesting of
antlerless deer in the districts or zones upon the recommendation
of the executive director based upon good and substantial
quantitative data and research evaluations that demonstrate that
the harvesting is necessary to properly manage the herd.
(b) The commission, only upon the recommendation of the

60 executive director, may allow the harvesting of antlerless deer 61 during the deer season with guns and with dogs by a majority vote

62 of the commission.

of either-sex deer by landowners or leaseholders on private lands
under the deer management assistance program prescribed or
approved by the executive director.

(4) The commission may provide a special permit for the harvesting of deer when they are depredating and destroying crops. The department shall supervise the harvesting and provide for the salvaging of the meat of the animals. The commission may authorize the department to assist any farmer in this state, who sustains crop damage by wildlife, in eradication of the problem wildlife.

74 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 75 and after July 1, 2011.
