HOUSE BILL NO. 1221

- AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE CREATION OF HUMAN-ANIMAL HYBRIDS; TO
- 2 PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; TO DEFINE CERTAIN TERMS; TO
- 3 PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to
- 6 knowingly:
- 7 (a) Create or attempt to create a human-animal hybrid;
- 8 (b) Transfer or attempt to transfer a human embryo into
- 9 a nonhuman womb; or
- 10 (c) Transfer or attempt to transfer a nonhuman embryo
- 11 into a human womb.
- 12 (2) Whoever violates this section shall be imprisoned for
- 13 not more than ten (10) years, or fined not more than Ten Thousand
- 14 Dollars (\$10,000.00), or both.
- 15 (3) Whoever violates this section and derives pecuniary gain
- 16 from the violation shall be subject to a civil fine of One Million
- 17 Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or an amount equal to the amount of the
- 18 gross gain multiplied by two (2).
- 19 (4) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 20 shall have the following meaning:
- 21 (a) "Human-animal hybrid" means:
- (i) A human embryo into which a nonhuman cell or
- 23 cells or the component parts thereof have been introduced or a
- 24 nonhuman embryo into which a human cell or cells or the component
- 25 parts thereof have been introduced;
- 26 (ii) A hybrid human-animal embryo produced by
- 27 fertilizing a human egg with a nonhuman sperm;

28 (iii) A hybrid human-animal embryo produced	by

- 29 fertilizing a nonhuman egg with human sperm;
- 30 (iv) An embryo produced by introducing a nonhuman
- 31 nucleus into a human egg;
- 32 (v) An embryo produced by introducing a human
- 33 nucleus into a nonhuman egg;
- 34 (vi) An embryo containing at least haploid sets of
- 35 chromosomes from both a human and a nonhuman life form;
- 36 (vii) A nonhuman life form engineered such that
- 37 human gametes develop within the body of a nonhuman life form; or
- 38 (viii) A nonhuman life form engineered such that
- 39 it contains a human brain or a brain derived wholly or
- 40 predominately from human neural tissues.
- 41 (b) "Human embryo" means an organism of the species
- 42 Homo sapiens during the earliest stages of development, from one
- 43 (1) cell up to eight (8) weeks.
- 44 (5) Nothing in this section shall be interpreted as
- 45 prohibiting either of the following if these do not violate the
- 46 prohibitions of subsection (1) or meet the definitions of
- 47 subsection (4) of this section:
- 48 (a) Research involving the use of transgenic animal
- 49 models containing human genes; or
- 50 (b) Xenotransplantation of human organs, tissues or
- 51 cells into recipient animals other than animal embryos.
- 52 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 53 and after July 1, 2011.
