HOUSE BILL NO. 1385 (As Sent to Governor)

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 17-2-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE MISSISSIPPI BUILDING CODES COUNCIL, 3 AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE COUNCIL SHALL NOT ENACT ANY ORDINANCE, BYLAW, ORDER, BUILDING CODE OR RULE REQUIRING THE INSTALLATION OF 5 A MULTIPURPOSE RESIDENTIAL FIRE PROTECTION SPRINKLER SYSTEM IN A
- 6 NEW OR EXISTING ONE- OR TWO-FAMILY DWELLING; AND FOR RELATED
- 7 PURPOSES.
- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 **SECTION 1.** Section 17-2-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 10 amended as follows:
- 11 17-2-3. (1) There is hereby created the Mississippi
- Building Codes Council. Each member of the council shall be 12
- appointed by the executive director of his respective professional 13
- association unless otherwise stated herein. Each member shall 14
- serve for a term of three (3) years and until a successor is 15
- 16 appointed and qualifies. No person who has previously been
- 17 convicted of a felony in this state or any other state may be
- appointed to the council. From and after July 1, 2009, all 18
- members of the council shall be residents of the State of 19
- Mississippi. The terms of the members serving on the council on 20
- 21 the effective date of this act shall expire on July 1, 2011.
- 22 council is hereby reconstituted and shall consist of the following
- eleven (11) members with terms beginning on July 1, 2011: 23
- 24 (a) One (1) representative of the American Institute of

Manufactured Housing Association; 30 (d) One (1) representative of the Building Officials 31 32 Association of Mississippi; 33 (e) Two (2) representatives of the Home Builders 34 Association of Mississippi; 35 (f) One (1) representative of the Associated Builders 36 and Contractors of Mississippi; (g) One (1) representative of the American Council of 37 Engineering Companies of Mississippi; 38 * * * 39 40 (h) One (1) representative of the Mississippi Municipal 41 League; * * * 42 43 (i) One (1) representative of the Mississippi Association of Supervisors; and 44 * * * 45 46 (j) The Mississippi State Fire Marshal, or his designee, to serve ex officio, nonvoting. 47 48 * * * A vacancy must be filled in the manner of the original 49 (2) 50 appointment for the unexpired portion of the term. 51 Any member with unexcused absences for more than three (3) consecutive meetings shall be replaced by his sponsoring 52 53 organization. 54 The State Fire Marshal shall convene the first meeting 55 of the reconstituted council before October 1, 2011, and shall act 56 as temporary chairman until the council elects from its members a 57 chairman and vice chairman. The council shall adopt regulations 58 consistent with this act. A meeting may be called by the chairman on his own initiative and must be called by him at the request of 59 60 three (3) or more members of the council. Each member must be notified by the chairman in writing of the time and place of the 61

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- 62 meeting at least seven (7) days before the meeting. Four (4)
- 63 members constitute a quorum. Each meeting is open to the public.
- 64 An official decision of the council may be made only by a vote of
- 65 at least two-thirds (2/3) of those members in attendance at the

- 67 (5) The council shall adopt by reference and amend only one
- 68 (1) of the last three (3) editions of the following as
- 69 discretionary statewide minimum codes:
- 70 (a) International Building Code and the standards
- 71 referenced in that code for regulation of construction within this
- 72 state. The appendices of that code may be adopted as needed, but
- 73 the specific appendix or appendices must be referenced by name or

- 77 construction within this state. The appendices of that code may
- 78 be adopted as needed, but the specific appendix or appendices must
- 79 be referenced by name or letter designation at the time of
- 80 adoption, with the exception of Appendix J, Existing Buildings and
- 81 Structures, which is hereby adopted by this reference.
- 82 (c) Other codes addressing matters such as electrical,
- 83 plumbing, mechanical, fire and fuel gas.
- 84 (6) The initial code or codes adopted by this council under
- 85 the provisions of this section shall be completed no later than
- 86 July 1, 2007.
- 87 (7) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the council
- 88 shall not enact any ordinance, bylaw, order, building code or rule
- 89 requiring the installation of a multipurpose residential fire
- 90 protection sprinkler system or any other fire sprinkler protection
- 91 system in a new or existing one- or two-family dwelling. However,
- 92 the county boards of supervisors and municipal governing
- 93 authorities may adopt, modify and enforce codes adopted by the
- 94 council, including the adoption of codes which require the

- 95 installation of fire protection sprinkler systems in any
- 96 <u>structure</u>.
- 97 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 98 and after its passage.
