WHEREAS, because babies born to mothers addicted to alcohol 21 22 and other drugs have a greater risk of being born too small, too soon and very sick, BornFree of Mississippi, Inc., working in 23 24 close partnership with Catholic Charities, Inc., provides 25 treatment services to clients at the BornFree Residential Treatment program and the Region I Mental Health facility at 26 27 Sunflower Landing in Dublin, Mississippi; and H.
