SENATE BILL NO. 2520

- 1 AN ACT TO ELIMINATE THE SECOND SEASON OF HUNTING DEER WITH
- 2 GUNS AND WITH DOGS ON THE HOMOCHITTO NATIONAL FOREST LANDS; AND
- 3 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 49-7-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 49-7-31. (1) The open season on deer shall be as follows:
- 8 (a) With bow and arrow: October 1 through the Friday
- 9 prior to Thanksgiving.
- 10 (b) With guns and with dogs: from the Saturday prior
- 11 to Thanksgiving through December 1.
- 12 (c) With primitive weapons and without dogs: December
- 13 2 through December 15.
- 14 (d) With guns and without dogs: December 16 through
- 15 December 23. However, the commission may allow hunting statewide
- or in specific areas with any legal weapon which it may designate
- 17 without dogs after the end of the last season for hunting deer
- 18 with guns and with dogs, but the season with legal designated
- 19 weapons and without dogs shall not extend beyond January 31.
- 20 (e) The commission shall establish an extended season
- 21 with primitive weapons and bow and arrow without dogs from
- 22 February 1 through February 15 for the area south of U.S. Highway
- 23 84 and east of Mississippi Highway 35 only for legal bucks. Any
- 24 antlered deer taken in this area during any open season under this
- 25 section must be a legal buck as defined in this paragraph. For
- 26 purposes of this paragraph, the term "legal buck" means a deer
- 27 with antlers of four (4) points or more with a minimum inside

- 28 spread of ten (10) inches or a minimum main beam length of
- 29 thirteen (13) inches. The commission may regulate the taking of
- 30 deer with antlers of four (4) points or less under this paragraph
- 31 for the proper management of antlered deer. The commission may
- 32 delay the opening date and change the length of bow and arrow
- 33 season in subsection (1)(a) in this area.
- 34 (f) With guns and with dogs: December 24 through a
- 35 date fixed by the commission that will provide a total of
- 36 thirty-nine (39) days of hunting deer with guns and with dogs when
- 37 added to the number of days provided for hunting deer with guns
- 38 and with dogs in paragraph (b). The season established in this
- 39 paragraph does not apply to the Homochitto National Forest lands.
- 40 A second season of hunting deer with guns and with dogs in the
- 41 Homochitto National Forest is prohibited.
- 42 (2) The commission may set and regulate the deer seasons on
- 43 wildlife management areas which it administers.
- 44 (3) (a) The commission may allow the harvesting of
- 45 antlerless deer in the districts or zones upon the recommendation
- 46 of the executive director based upon good and substantial
- 47 quantitative data and research evaluations that demonstrate that
- 48 the harvesting is necessary to properly manage the herd.
- 49 (b) The commission, only upon the recommendation of the
- 50 executive director, may allow the harvesting of antlerless deer
- 51 during the deer season with guns and with dogs by a majority vote
- 52 of the commission.
- (c) Nothing in this subsection prohibits the harvesting
- of either-sex deer by landowners or leaseholders on private lands
- 55 under the deer management assistance program prescribed or
- 56 approved by the executive director.
- 57 (4) The commission may provide a special permit for the
- 58 harvesting of deer when they are depredating and destroying crops.
- 59 The department shall supervise the harvesting and provide for the
- 60 salvaging of the meat of the animals. The commission may

- 61 authorize the department to assist any farmer in this state, who
- 62 sustains crop damage by wildlife, in eradication of the problem
- 63 wildlife.
- 64 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 65 and after July 1, 2011.
