HOUSE BILL NO. 843

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-47, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
- 2 LESSEN THE PENALTY IMPOSED FOR HUNTING OR TRAPPING ALLIGATORS AND
- 3 ALLIGATOR TURTLES OUT OF SEASON WITHOUT THE REQUIRED PERMIT; AND
- 4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 49-7-47, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 49-7-47. (1) The commission may control, regulate and
- 9 manage the taking of all alligators.
- 10 (2) Residents and nonresidents shall be required to purchase
- 11 a combination hunting and fishing license to hunt, kill or catch
- 12 any alligator for sporting purposes.
- 13 (3) Residents and nonresidents shall be required to obtain a
- 14 special permit to hunt, kill, catch or possess any alligator for
- 15 commercial purposes. The commission may establish a reasonable
- 16 fee for an annual special sporting permit, not to exceed Two
- 17 Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), and may prescribe regulations governing
- 18 commercial trade in alligators. Any reasonable fee established
- 19 for an annual special commercial permit shall not exceed Five
- 20 Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). Such permit shall be good from the
- 21 date of its issuance to June 30 following its date.
- 22 (4) Any person violating this section is guilty, upon
- 23 conviction, of a Class II offense and is punishable as provided in
- 24 Section 49-7-143.
- 25 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 2012.
