HOUSE BILL NO. 1095

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-103-25, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER
- 3 LEARNING TO ALLOW INSTITUTIONS TO WAIVE OUT-OF-STATE TUITION WHEN
- 4 ACCORDANCE WITH A WAIVER POLICY IS REQUESTED BY THE PRESIDENT OR
- 5 CHANCELLOR OF THE INSTITUTION AND DETERMINED TO BE FISCALLY
- 6 RESPONSIBLE BY THE BOARD; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 37-103-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 37-103-25. (1) The Board of Trustees of State Institutions
- 11 of Higher Learning and the boards of trustees of the community
- 12 colleges and junior colleges are authorized to prescribe the
- 13 amount of tuition and fees to be paid by students attending the
- 14 several state-supported institutions of higher learning and
- 15 community colleges and junior colleges of the State of
- 16 Mississippi.
- 17 (2) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection and
- 18 subsection (3) of this section, the total tuition to be paid by
- 19 residents of other states shall not be less than the average cost
- 20 per student from appropriated funds. However, the tuition to be
- 21 paid by a resident of another state shall be equal to the tuition
- 22 amount established under subsection (1) of this section if:
- 23 (a) The nonresident student was born in the State of
- 24 Mississippi but subsequently relocated and resided outside the
- 25 state as a minor under the care of the minor's father or mother,
- 26 or both;
- 27 (b) The nonresident student is a veteran who served in
- 28 the Armed Forces of the United States;

29	(c) The nonresident student is domiciled in Mississippi
30	no later than six (6) months after the nonresident student's
31	separation from service, as evidenced by a Report of Separation
32	from Military Service or other military discharge document, for
33	the purpose of enrolling in a state institution of higher learning
34	or a community or junior college; * * *
35	(d) The nonresident student is an evacuee of an area
36	affected by Hurricane Katrina or Hurricane Rita. This waiver
37	shall be applicable to the 2005-2006 school year only; or
38	(e) The nonresident student's out-of-state tuition was
39	waived according to subsection (3) of this section.
40	(3) The Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher
41	Learning may, in its discretion, consider and grant requests to
42	approve institution specific policies permitting the waiver of
43	out-of-state tuition when such an official request is made by the
44	president or chancellor of the institution and when such request
45	is determined by the board to be fiscally responsible and in
46	accordance with the educational mission of the requesting
47	institution.
48	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
49	and after July 1, 2012.
