## SENATE BILL NO. 2137

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE RETAIL DEALERS AND DISTRIBUTORS OF GASOLINE 2 TO OFFER FOR SALE OR USE NONETHANOL-BLENDED UNLEADED PREMIUM GRADE 3 GASOLINE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** (1) For the purposes of this section, the following terms shall have the meanings ascribed below, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

8 (a) "Antiknock index number" means the number assigned 9 to a spark ignition engine fuel that designates the fuel's ability 10 to resist engine knock.

(b) "Distributor" shall mean any person engaged in the sale, consignment or distribution of petroleum products to wholesale or retail outlets, whether or not such person owns, leases or in any way controls such outlets.

(c) "Retail dealer" shall mean any person who operates a service station, filling station, store, garage or other place of business for the sale of motor fuel for delivery into the service tank or tanks of any vehicle propelled by an internal combustion engine.

20 (d) "Retail fuel outlet" shall mean a place at which 21 gasoline and oil are stored and supplied to the public, which is 22 operated directly by a refiner or distributor.

(2) Any retail dealer and any distributor, doing business in
the State of Mississippi, shall hold, store, import, transfer and
offer for sale or use nonethanol-blended unleaded premium grade
gasoline with an antiknock index number of 91 or greater.

30 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 31 and after July 1, 2012.
