SENATE BILL NO. 2324

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 83-51-31, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REMOVE THE REPEALER ON THE SECTION WHICH PROVIDES PROHIBITIONS 3 AGAINST CERTAIN PROVISIONS IN CONTRACTS BETWEEN HEALTH CARE 4 ENTITIES AND DENTISTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 83-51-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

8 83-51-31. \* \* \* No contract between a health care entity 9 that offers a dental plan or plans and a dentist for the provision 10 of services to subscribers may require that a dentist provide services to his subscribers at a fee set by the health care entity 11 unless the services are covered services under the applicable 12 13 subscriber agreement. For the purposes of this section, "covered services" means services that are reimbursable under the 14 15 applicable subscriber agreement, notwithstanding any deductibles, waiting periods or frequency limitations that may apply. For the 16 purposes of this section, "dental plan" means any policy of 17 insurance that is issued by a health care entity that provides for 18 19 coverage of dental services not in connection with a medical plan. 20 \* \* \*

21 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 22 and after July 1, 2012.
