- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 49-7-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 49-7-31. (1) The open season on deer shall be as follows:
- 9 (a) With bow and arrow: October 1 through the Friday
- 10 prior to Thanksgiving.
- 11 (b) With guns and with dogs: from the Saturday prior
- 12 to Thanksgiving through December 1.
- 13 (c) With primitive weapons and without dogs: December
- 14 2 through December 15.
- 15 (d) With guns and without dogs: December 16 through
- 16 December 23. However, the commission may allow hunting statewide
- 17 or in specific areas with any legal weapon which it may designate
- 18 without dogs after the end of the last season for hunting deer
- 19 with guns and with dogs, but the season with legal designated
- 20 weapons and without dogs shall not extend beyond January 31. In
- 21 any primitive weapon season after the last season for hunting deer
- 22 with guns and with dogs, a landowner or a leaseholder of private
- 23 lands may use the weapon of his choice.
- 24 (e) The commission shall establish an extended season
- 25 with primitive weapons and bow and arrow without dogs from
- 26 February 1 through February 15 for the area south of U.S. Highway
- 27 84 and east of Mississippi Highway 35 only for legal bucks. Any
- 28 antlered deer taken in this area during any open season under this S. B. No. 2575 G1/2 12/SS01/R1135 PAGE 1

- 29 section must be a legal buck as defined in this paragraph. For
- 30 purposes of this paragraph, the term "legal buck" means a deer
- 31 with antlers of four (4) points or more with a minimum inside
- 32 spread of ten (10) inches or a minimum main beam length of
- 33 thirteen (13) inches. The commission may regulate the taking of
- 34 deer with antlers of four (4) points or less under this paragraph
- 35 for the proper management of antlered deer. The commission may
- 36 delay the opening date and change the length of bow and arrow
- 37 season in subsection (1)(a) in this area.
- 38 (f) With guns and with dogs: December 24 through a
- 39 date fixed by the commission that will provide a total of
- 40 thirty-nine (39) days of hunting deer with guns and with dogs when
- 41 added to the number of days provided for hunting deer with guns
- 42 and with dogs in paragraph (b).
- 43 (2) The commission may set and regulate the deer seasons on
- 44 wildlife management areas which it administers.
- 45 (3) (a) The commission may allow the harvesting of
- 46 antlerless deer in the districts or zones upon the recommendation
- 47 of the executive director based upon good and substantial
- 48 quantitative data and research evaluations that demonstrate that
- 49 the harvesting is necessary to properly manage the herd.
- 50 (b) The commission, only upon the recommendation of the
- 51 executive director, may allow the harvesting of antlerless deer
- 52 during the deer season with guns and with dogs by a majority vote
- 53 of the commission.
- 54 (c) Nothing in this subsection prohibits the harvesting
- of either-sex deer by landowners or leaseholders on private lands
- 56 under the deer management assistance program prescribed or
- 57 approved by the executive director.
- 58 (4) The commission may provide a special permit for the
- 59 harvesting of deer when they are depredating and destroying crops.
- 60 The department shall supervise the harvesting and provide for the

- 61 salvaging of the meat of the animals. The commission may
- 62 authorize the department to assist any farmer in this state, who
- 63 sustains crop damage by wildlife, in eradication of the problem
- 64 wildlife.
- 65 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 66 and after July 1, 2012.
