11 WHEREAS, the Turquoise Council of Americans and Eurasians 12 (TCAE) is an independent nonprofit organization that facilitates 13 the mutually beneficial economic relationship between Mississippi 14 and Eurasia, fosters interfaith dialog between religions, and is 15 committed to promoting positive relationships between American and 16 Turkish, Turkic and Eurasian people, regardless of their ethnic 17 origin, religion and other preferences; and

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2012, there is a major "Mississippi 18 Azerbaijan and Turkey Business Forum" to facilitate commerce 19 20 between Mississippi, Turkey and Eurasia and develop new partnerships between Turkish, Azeri and Mississippi businessmen. 21 22 The summit will consist of conferences, field trips, matchmakings 23 and workshops. Mississippi Development Authority, Mississippi Economic Council, World Trade Center and Greater Jackson Chamber 24 of Commerce and Turquoise Council of Americans and Eurasians will 25 involve the activities as sponsors.
