- Amend the Mississippi Constitution of 1890 by recreating 8
- 9 Section 19 to read as follows:
- 10 Section 19. The people have the right to hunt, to fish, and
- to harvest wildlife, including by the use of traditional methods, 11
- 12 subject to laws and regulations that promote wildlife conservation
- and management and that preserve the future of hunting and 13
- 14 fishing. Public hunting and fishing shall be a preferred means of
- managing and controlling wildlife. This section shall not be 15
- construed to modify any provision of law relating to trespass, 16
- property rights, or the maintenance of levees pursuant to Article 17
- 18 11.
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this amendment shall be
- submitted to the qualified electors at an election to be held on 20
- 21 the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November 2012, as
- provided by Section 273 of the Constitution and by law. 22
- 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed
- constitutional amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: 24
- "This amendment establishes hunting and fishing as a 25
- 26 constitutional right, subject to applicable laws and regulations
- promoting wildlife conservation." 27
