HOUSE BILL NO. 22
(As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION OF CAPITAL EXPENSE
2 FUNDS AND/OR BUDGET CONTINGENCY FUNDS TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF
3 THE OFFICE OF STATE AID ROAD CONSTRUCTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI
4 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR FISCAL YEARS 2013 AND 2014; THE
5 DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION FOR FISCAL YEARS 2013 AND
6 2014; DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE FOR FISCAL YEARS 2013 AND 2014; AND
7 THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013; AND
8 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

10 **SECTION 1.** In addition to all other sums herein
11 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
13 Treasury to the credit of the Capital Expense Fund, and allocated
14 in a manner as determined by the Treasurer's Office, to defray the
15 expenses of the Office of State Aid Road Construction of the
16 Mississippi Department of Transportation, for the period beginning
17 upon the passage of this act and through June 30, 2014.....
18\$ 20,000,000.00.

19 This additional appropriation is made for the purpose of
20 providing funds for the Local System Bridge Replacement and



21 Rehabilitation Fund created under Section 65-37-13, Mississippi
22 Code of 1972.

23 **SECTION 2.** In addition to all other sums herein
24 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
25 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
26 Treasury to the credit of the Capital Expense Fund, and allocated
27 in a manner as determined by the Treasurer's Office, to defray the
28 expenses of the Department of Finance and Administration, acting
29 through the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property
30 Management, for the period beginning upon the passage of this act
31 and through June 30, 2014.....\$ 26,000,000.00.

32 This additional appropriation is made for the purpose of
33 providing the funds necessary to authorize the expenditure of
34 funds for construction and/or repair and renovation projects at
35 various state agencies and institutions as allocated herein:

36 Institutions of Higher Learning (IHL), for the replacement of
37 "F" rated roofs at IHL campuses statewide.....\$ 11,000,000.00,
38 Jackson State University (JSU), for the waterproofing of the
39 Administration Tower.....\$1,000,000.00,
40 Community and Junior Colleges (CJC), for the replacement of
41 "F" rated roofs at CJC campuses statewide.....\$5,000,000.00,
42 Department of Mental Health (DMH), for the replacement of
43 roofs at DMH.....\$4,000,000.00,
44 Miscellaneous Agencies, for the replacement of roofs at any
45 other qualified agencies statewide.....\$5,000,000.00.



46 **SECTION 3.** In addition to all other sums herein
47 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
48 necessary is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury
49 to the credit of the Capital Expense Fund, and allocated in a
50 manner as determined by the Treasurer's Office, to defray the
51 expenses of the Department of Finance and Administration, for the
52 period beginning upon the passage of this act and through June 30,
53 2014.....\$22,000,000.00.

54 This additional appropriation is made for the purpose of
55 providing the funds necessary to continue the operations of the
56 MAGIC project, the State's primary data processing system for
57 tracking, managing, and reporting critical financial information.

58 **SECTION 4.** In addition to all other sums herein
59 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
60 necessary is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury
61 to the credit of the Budget Contingency Fund, and allocated in a
62 manner as determined by the Treasurer's Office, to defray the
63 expenses of the Department of Insurance for the Rural Fire Truck
64 Acquisition Assistance Program, for the period beginning upon the
65 passage of this act and through June 30, 2014.....\$3,000,000.00.

66 **SECTION 5.** In addition to all other sums herein
67 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
68 necessary is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury
69 to the credit of the Budget Contingency Fund, and allocated in a
70 manner as determined by the Treasurer's Office, to defray the



71 expenses of the Mississippi Development Authority, for the period
72 beginning upon the passage of this act and through June 30, 2014..
73\$1,600,000.00.

74 This additional appropriation is made for the purpose of
75 providing the funds necessary to defray the costs of the Cleveland
76 Music Foundation for the GRAMMY Museum in Cleveland, Mississippi.

77 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
78 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
79 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
80 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
81 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
82 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

83 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
84 and after its passage.
