HOUSE BILL NO. 174

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-47, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 REDUCE THE PENALTY IMPOSED FOR HUNTING OR TRAPPING ALLIGATORS OUT 3 OF SEASON WITHOUT THE REQUIRED PERMIT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 49-7-47, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 49-7-47. (1) The commission may control, regulate and 7 manage the taking of all alligators. 8 9 (2) Residents and nonresidents shall be required to purchase a combination hunting and fishing license to hunt, kill or catch 10 11 any alligator for sporting purposes. 12 (3) Residents and nonresidents shall be required to obtain a special permit to hunt, kill, catch or possess any alligator for 13 14 commercial purposes. The commission may establish a reasonable fee for an annual special sporting permit, not to exceed Two 15 Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), and may prescribe regulations governing 16 commercial trade in alligators. Any reasonable fee established 17 18 for an annual special commercial permit shall not exceed Five

(4) Any person violating this section is guilty, upon
conviction, of a Class * * * <u>II</u> offense and is punishable as
provided in Section * * * <u>49-7-143</u>.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 25 and after July 1, 2013.
