HOUSE BILL NO. 1458

- AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE SALE OF GIFT CARDS OR CERTIFICATES
 WITH EXPIRATION DATES, SERVICE FEES OR DORMANCY FEES; TO PROVIDE
 EXCEPTIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) It is unlawful for any person or entity to
- 6 sell a gift card or certificate to a purchaser that contains any
- 7 of the following:
- 8 (a) An expiration date.
- 9 (b) A service fee, including, but not limited to, a
- 10 service fee for dormancy, except as otherwise provided in
- 11 subsection (5).
- 12 (2) A gift card or certificate sold without an expiration
- 13 date is valid until redeemed or replaced.
- 14 (3) This section does not apply to any of the following gift
- 15 cards or certificates issued on or after July 1, 2013, provided
- 16 the expiration date appears in capital letters in at least
- 17 ten-point font on the front of the gift card or certificate:

- 18 (a) A gift card or certificate that is distributed by
- 19 the issuer to a consumer pursuant to an awards, loyalty or
- 20 promotional program without any money or other thing of value
- 21 being given in exchange for the gift certificate by the consumer.
- 22 (b) A gift card or certificate that is sold below face
- 23 value at a volume discount to employers or to nonprofit and
- 24 charitable organizations for fundraising purposes if the
- 25 expiration date on the gift card or certificate is not more than
- 26 thirty (30) days after the date of sale.
- 27 (c) A gift card or certificate that is issued for a
- 28 food product.
- 29 (4) The provisions of subsection (1) (b) do not apply to a
- 30 dormancy fee on a gift card that meets all of the following
- 31 criteria:
- 32 (a) The remaining value of the gift card is Five
- 33 Dollars (\$5.00) or less each time the fee is assessed.
- 34 (b) The fee does not exceed One Dollar (\$1.00) per
- 35 month.
- 36 (c) There has been no activity on the gift card for
- 37 twenty-four (24) consecutive months, including, but not limited
- 38 to, purchases, the adding of value or balance inquiries.
- 39 (d) The holder may reload or add value to the gift
- 40 card.
- 41 (e) A statement is printed on the gift card in at least
- 42 10-point font stating the amount of the fee, how often the fee

- 43 will occur, that the fee is triggered by inactivity of the gift
- 44 card, and at what point the fee will be charged. The statement
- 45 may appear on the front or back of the gift card, but shall appear
- 46 in a location where it is visible to any purchaser before the
- 47 purchase thereof.
- 48 (5) Nothing in subsection (1)(a) prevents an issuer of a
- 49 gift card or certificate from including on any gift card or
- 50 certificate a provision that entitles the purchaser to a full
- 51 refund of the amount that he or she paid for that gift card or
- 52 certificate upon the occurrence of the following circumstances:
- 53 (a) The gift card or certificate is purchased as a gift
- 54 for another person.
- 55 (b) The time period within which the gift certificate
- 56 may be redeemed is disclosed on the gift card or certificate.
- 57 (c) The holder of the gift card or certificate does not
- 58 redeem the gift card or certificate within the time described in
- 59 paragraph (b) of this subsection (5).
- 60 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 61 and after July 1, 2013.
