SENATE BILL NO. 2553 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO EXEMPT COTTAGE FOOD PRODUCTION OPERATIONS FROM 2 REGULATION; TO RENAME THE MISSISSIPPI SMALL FARM DEVELOPMENT CENTER AT ALCORN STATE UNIVERSITY AS THE MISSISSIPPI SMALL FARM 3 4 AND AGRIBUSINESS CENTER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 **SECTION 1.** (1) (a) A cottage food operation must comply 7 with the applicable requirements of this chapter but is exempt from the permitting requirements of Section 41-3-18 if the cottage 8 9 food operation complies with the section and has annual gross 10 sales of cottage food products that do not exceed Twenty Thousand 11 Dollars (\$20,000.00). 12 (b) For purposes of this subsection, a cottage food 13 operations annual gross sales include all sales of cottage food

14 products at any location, regardless of the types of products sold 15 or the number of persons involved in the operation. A cottage 16 food operation must provide the department, upon request, with 17 written documentation to verify the operation's annual gross 18 sales. 19 (2) A cottage food operation may not sell or offer for sale 20 cottage food products over the Internet, by mail order, or at 21 wholesale or to a retail establishment. Cottage food products are 22 nonpotentially hazardous food products as defined by the 23 department.

(3) A cottage food operation may only sell cottage food
products which are prepackaged with a label affixed that contains
the following information:

(a) The name and address of the cottage food operation.(b) The name of the cottage food product.

29 (c) The ingredients of the cottage food product, in30 descending order of predominance by weight.

31 (d) The net weight or net volume of the cottage food 32 product.

33 (e) Allergen information as specified by federal34 labeling requirements.

35 (f) If any nutritional claim is made, appropriate 36 nutritional information as specified by federal labeling 37 requirements.

38 (g) The following statement printed in at least 39 ten-point type in a color that provides a clear contrast to the 40 background of the label: "Made in a cottage food operation that 41 is not subject to Mississippi's food safety regulations."

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42 (4) This section does not exempt a cottage food operation
43 from any federal tax law, rule, regulation, or certificate that
44 applies to all cottage food operations.

(5) (a) The department may investigate any complaint which
alleges that a cottage food operation has violated an applicable
provision of this chapter or rule adopted under this chapter.

(b) Only upon receipt of a complaint, the department's authorized officer or employee may enter and inspect the premises of a cottage food operation to determine compliance with this chapter and department rules. A cottage food operation's refusal to permit the department's authorized officer or employee entry to the premises or to conduct the inspection is grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to Section 41-3-59.

55 (6) This section does not apply to a person operating under 56 a food permit issued pursuant to Section 41-3-18.

57 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The Mississippi Small Farm Development Center 58 (MSFDC) on the campus of Alcorn State University in Lorman, 59 Mississippi, shall be renamed the Mississippi Small Farm and 60 Agribusiness Center (MSFAC).

61 **SECTION <u>3</u>**. This act shall take effect and be in force from 62 and after its passage.
