- 10 of this state, another state, or in federal court of any felony in
- 11 which public funds were unlawfully taken, obtained or
- 12 misappropriated in the abuse or misuse of the person's office or
- 13 employment or money coming into the person's hands by virtue of
- 14 the person's office or employment.
