HOUSE BILL NO. 1233

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 57-26-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO EXTEND THE AUTHORITY OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY
- 3 TO ISSUE CERTIFICATES DESIGNATING ENTITIES AS APPROVED
- 4 PARTICIPANTS IN THE TOURISM PROJECT SALES TAX INCENTIVE PROGRAM
- 5 AND AUTHORIZING APPROVED PARTICIPANTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE
- 6 PROGRAM; TO AMEND SECTION 57-26-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
- 7 EXTEND THE AUTHORITY OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO
- 8 APPROVE APPLICATIONS FOR PROJECTS THAT INCLUDES ANY RESORT
- 9 DEVELOPMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 11 **SECTION 1.** Section 57-26-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 12 amended as follows:
- 57-26-5. (1) The MDA shall develop, implement and
- 14 administer the incentive program authorized in Sections 57-26-1
- 15 through 57-26-5 and shall promulgate rules and regulations
- 16 necessary for the development, implementation and administration
- 17 of such program.
- 18 (2) A person, corporation or other entity desiring to
- 19 participate in the incentive program authorized in Sections
- 20 57-26-1 through 57-26-5 must submit an application and an
- 21 application fee in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00)

- 22 to the MDA. Such application must contain (a) plans for the
- 23 proposed tourism project; (b) a detailed description of the
- 24 proposed tourism project; (c) the method of financing the proposed
- 25 tourism project and the terms of such financing; (d) an
- 26 independent study that identifies the number of out-of-state
- 27 visitors anticipated to visit the project and the ratio of
- 28 out-of-state visitors to in-state visitors; and (e) any other
- 29 information required by the MDA. The Executive Director of the
- 30 MDA shall review the application and determine if it qualifies as
- 31 a tourism project under this section and under the rules and
- 32 regulations promulgated pursuant to this section. If the
- 33 executive director determines the proposed tourism project
- 34 qualifies as a tourism project under this section and under the
- 35 rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to this section, he
- 36 shall issue a certificate to the person, corporation or other
- 37 entity designating such person, corporation or other entity as an
- 38 approved participant and authorizing the approved participant to
- 39 participate in the incentive program provided for in Sections
- 40 57-26-1 through 57-26-5. No certificate designating an entity as
- 41 an approved participant and authorizing the approved participant
- 42 to participate in the incentive program shall be issued from and
- 43 after July 1, * * * 2017.
- 44 (3) The MDA shall cause a cost benefit analysis of the
- 45 tourism project to be performed by a state institution of higher

- 46 learning, the university research center or some other entity
- 47 approved by the MDA.
- 48 **SECTION 2.** Section 57-26-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 49 amended as follows:
- 50 57-26-7. The MDA shall not approve any application submitted
- 51 after June 30, * * * 2017, pursuant to Section 57-26-5 for a
- 52 project that includes any resort development.
- 53 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 54 and after July 1, 2014.
