AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO**

**Senate Bill No. 2681**

**BY: Senator(s) Polk, Burton, Parker, Ward, Watson**

1           **AMEND after line 52 by inserting the following section and**  
2 **renumber succeeding sections**

3           **SECTION \***. The 1818 Mississippi Laws, Act of January 19,  
4 1818, Page 142 is amended as follows:

5           **Section 1.** Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of  
6 Representatives of the State of Mississippi in General Assembly  
7 convened, That it shall be the duty of the Secretary of State to  
8 procure the seal of this state, the inscription of which shall be,  
9 "THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI," around the margin,  
10 and in the center an eagle, which the olive branch and quiver of  
11 arrows in his claws and below the eagle in the margin shall be the  
12 phrase "IN GOD WE TRUST."

13           **Section 2.** And be it further enacted, That is shall be the  
14 duty of the clerk of each superior court within this state, to



15 procure, at the county expense, a seal for the use of their  
16 respective counties, with the name of the county around the  
17 margin, and in the center an eagle.

18 **SECTION \*.** All state agencies shall continue to use  
19 stationary and other supplies having the great seal of 1818  
20 thereon until such stationary and other supplies are depleted.  
21 The great seal of 1818 affixed on any public buildings or other  
22 property shall remain thereon until the replacement of the seal  
23 due to normal wear.

24 **AMEND title line 4 after the semi-colon insert the following:**

25 TO AMEND THE 1818 MISSISSIPPI LAWS, ACT OF JANUARY 19,  
26 1818, PAGE 142, TO REVISE THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF  
27 MISSISSIPPI; TO PROVIDE THAT STATE AGENCIES SHALL CONTINUE TO USE  
28 STATIONARY AND OTHER SUPPLIES HAVING THE 1818 SEAL THEREON UNTIL  
29 SUPPLIES OF SUCH ITEMS ARE DEPLETED;
