## HOUSE BILL NO. 160

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 91-7-259, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
TO PROVIDE THAT ANY PERSON OR FINANCIAL INSTITUTION MAY TURN OVER
PERSONAL PROPERTY OR FUNDS OF A DECEDENT IN ITS POSSESSION TO AN
EXECUTOR OR ADMINISTRATOR WHO HAS QUALIFIED IN ANOTHER STATE AND
MAY RELY UPON A CERTIFIED COPY OF THE RECORD OF THE APPOINTMENT
AND QUALIFICATION OF THE EXECUTOR OR ADMINISTRATOR ACCORDING TO
THE LAW OF THE STATE WHERE HE IS QUALIFIED; AND FOR RELATED
PURPOSES.

- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 10 **SECTION 1.** Section 91-7-259, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 11 amended as follows:
- 12 91-7-259. Executors and administrators who have qualified in
- 13 other states or countries may sue in the courts of this state, or
- 14 may receive without suit and give a valid acquittance for any
- 15 personal property or funds on deposit of, or debts due to, their
- 16 testators or intestates, \* \* \* and in turning over that property
- or those funds or paying those debts to such an executor or
- 18 administrator, any person, bank or other financial institution in
- 19 this state who is
- 20 indebted to the decedent or has some personal property in

21 possession or funds on deposit may rely without further inquiry

- 22 upon a certified copy of the record of the appointment and
- 23 qualification of the executor or administrator according to the
- 24 law of the state or country where he is qualified \* \* \*.
- 25 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 2015.
