HOUSE BILL NO. 661 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-105-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE A UNIVERSITY'S LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO ENFORCE THE LAWS OF THE STATE ON PROPERTY THAT IS WITHIN 500 FEET OF ANY PROPERTY OWNED BY THE UNIVERSITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-105-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 37-105-3. (1) The traffic officers duly appointed by the
- 9 president of any state institution of higher learning, or any
- 10 peace officer or highway patrolman of this state, are vested with
- 11 the powers and authority to perform all duties incident to
- 12 enforcing such rules and regulations as may be enacted under the
- 13 authority granted in Section 37-105-1, including the arrest of
- 14 violators.
- 15 (2) The peace officers duly * * * appointed by * * * the
- 16 president of any state institution of higher learning are also
- 17 vested with the powers and subjected to the duties of a constable
- 18 for the purpose of preventing all violations of law that occur
- 19 within five hundred (500) feet of any property owned by the

- 20 university, if such universities determine that they want such
- 21 peace officers to exercise such powers and if reasonably
- 22 determined to have a possible impact on the safety of students,
- 23 faculty or staff of the university while on said property. If a
- 24 university determines that it wants such peace officers to
- 25 exercise such powers, the university may enter into an interlocal
- 26 agreement with other law enforcement entities specifying the
- 27 individual and joint duties to be exercised on property within the
- 28 peace officers' jurisdiction. Provided, however, that nothing in
- 29 this section shall be interpreted to require action by any such
- 30 peace officer appointed by such universities to events occurring
- 31 outside the boundaries of university property, nor shall any such
- 32 university or its employees be liable for any failure to act to
- 33 any event occurring outside the boundaries of property owned by
- 34 the university.
- * * * With approval from the Board of Trustees of State
- 36 Institutions of Higher Learning, the university may enter into an
- 37 interlocal agreement with other law enforcement entities for the
- 38 provision of equipment or traffic control duties, however, the
- 39 duty to enforce traffic regulations and to enforce the laws of the
- 40 state or municipality off of university property lies with the
- 41 local police or sheriff's department which cannot withhold its
- 42 services solely because of the lack of such an agreement.
- 43 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 44 and after July 1, 2015.
