6	SECTION 1. Section 49-7-147, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7	amended as follows:
8	49-7-147. (1) No person shall intentionally:
9	(a) Interfere with or attempt to prevent the lawful
10	taking of wildlife by another;
11	(b) Attempt to disturb wildlife, or attempt to affect
12	their behavior with the intent to prevent their lawful taking by
13	another; * * *
14	(c) Harass another person who is engaged in the lawful
15	taking of wildlife or in the preparation for such taking * * * ; or
16	(d) Use an unmanned system to conduct video
17	surveillance of a person lawfully engaged in any hunting, trapping
18	or fishing activities, or in violation of paragraphs (a) through
19	(c) of this subsection. For purposes of this section, "unmanned

20 system," means any mechanical aircraft, overland vehicle or 21 watercraft that is pilotless and is either remotely and fully 22 controlled from another location or programmed and fully 23 autonomous. 24 (2) Any person who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a Class II violation, punishable as provided in Section 49-7-143, 25 26 Mississippi Code of 1972. 27 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

28 and after July 1, 2015.
