HOUSE BILL NO. 951 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSION ON COLLEGE ACCREDITATION 2 TO ADMINISTER INTERSTATE RECIPROCITY AGREEMENTS THAT WILL ALLOW 3 APPROVED INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING AND REGISTERED 4 PROPRIETARY SCHOOLS TO OFFER POSTSECONDARY DISTANCE EDUCATION; AND 5 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 37-101-243, Mississippi Code of 1972: 8 9 37-101-243. (1) For the purposes of this section, these 10 words are defined as follows: (a) "Commission" means the Commission on College 11 Accreditation created under Section 37-101-241; and 12 (b) "Institution" means and includes institutions of 13 14 higher learning approved under Section 37-101-241 and proprietary 15 schools and other entities subject to regulation under Section 16 75-60-1 et seq. 17 (2) The commission may enter into and administer interstate 18 reciprocity agreements that allow institutions to offer 19 postsecondary distance education. The commission is further

20 authorized to carry out the following duties as related to 21 interstate reciprocity agreements: 22 Approve or disapprove participation in these (a) 23 agreements by institutions; 24 Establish fees to be paid by participating (b) institutions to cover the commission's direct and indirect 25 26 administrative costs: Serve as the state point of contact for questions, 27 (C) 28 complaints and other communications; 29 (d) Enter into agreements with other state agencies 30 regarding state responsibilities; and 31 Form committees to assist in establishing policies (e) 32 and procedures. 33 The commission shall not: (3)34 Require institutions to participate in interstate (a) 35 reciprocity agreements; or 36 (b) Prohibit institutions that do not participate in these agreements from offering postsecondary distance education. 37 38 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 39 and after July 1, 2015.
