## SENATE BILL NO. 2219

AN ACT TO BE KNOWN AS KEYAURDRA'S LAW; TO CREATE NEW SECTION 1 2 97-37-39, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THAT ALL 3 CENTER-FIRE PISTOL AND RIFLE CARTRIDGES SOLD IN MISSISSIPPI BEAR A UNIQUE IDENTIFYING MARK; TO REQUIRE SELLERS OF AMMUNITION TO KEEP 4 5 RECORDS AS TO THE PURCHASER OF SUCH AMMUNITION BY SERIAL NUMBER OR 6 OTHER UNIQUE IDENTIFYING MARK; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 97-37-39, Mississippi Code of 1972: 9 10 97-37-39. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to sell any center-fire pistol or rifle cartridge that does not bear on 11 12 the casing thereof a serial number or other unique identifying 13 mark. 14 (2) (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to sell any 15 center-fire pistol or rifle cartridge without making a record of the serial numbers or other unique identifying mark of the 16

17 cartridges sold.

(b) Records required under this section shall be
retained by the seller for not less than five (5) years from the
date of sale.
