HOUSE BILL NO. 582

1 AN ACT TO CREATE THE "DRONE REGULATION ACT"; TO PROVIDE 2 DEFINITIONS FOR SUCH ACT; TO REGULATE THE USE OF DRONES IN THE 3 CAPTURING OF IMAGES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. This act shall be known and hereinafter referred 5 to as the "Drone Regulation Act." 6 **SECTION 2.** For purposes of this act, the following words 7 shall have the meaning ascribed herein unless the context shall 8 9 otherwise require: (a) "Image" means any capturing of sound waves, 10 11 thermal, infrared, ultraviolet, visible light, or other electromagnetic waves, odor, or other conditions existing on or 12 13 about real property in this state or an individual located on that 14 property; and "Drone" means any unmanned airborne device that is 15 (b) 16 operated without an individual in or on the device. 17 **SECTION 3.** (1) Except as otherwise provided in this 18 section, it shall be unlawful for any person to capture an G1/2H. 19 unauthorized image using a drone, as defined by this act. For 20 purposes of this act, the term "unauthorized" means without the 21 consent or approval of the person or owner or custodian, as 22 applicable, of the person, property or other entity of which an 23 image is captured.

(2) The provisions of subsection (1) of this section shallnot apply to:

(a) Any person who is conducting professional or
scholarly research and development and acting on behalf of an
institution of higher learning, if such person is a professor,
employee, or student of the institution; or under contract with or
otherwise acting under the direction of or on behalf of the
institution;

(m) For the purpose of rescuing a person whose life orwell-being is in imminent danger;

(n) If the image is captured by a Mississippi licensed real estate broker in connection with the marketing, sale, or financing of real property, provided that no individual is identifiable in the image;

(p) If the image is captured by the owner or operator of an oil, gas, water, or other pipeline for the purpose of inspecting, maintaining, or repairing pipelines or other related facilities, and is captured without the intent to conduct surveillance on an individual or real property located in this state;

86 (q) In connection with oil and gas pipeline and well87 safety and protection;

88 (r) In connection with port authority surveillance and89 security; or

90 (s) An image captured by a state or local government 91 agency, or by a person who is under contract with or otherwise

95 SECTION 4. Any person violating the provisions of this act shall be fined not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or 96 97 imprisoned for not more than six (6) months, or both. Each image captured in violation of this act shall be a separate offense. 98 The amount of the fine for any subsequent violation of this act 99 100 shall be no less than One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00). The time for imprisonment for any subsequent 101 violation of this act shall be at least twelve (12) months in the 102 103 State Penitentiary.

104 **SECTION 5.** The provisions of this act shall apply unless 105 preempted by applicable federal law or by regulations adopted by 106 the Federal Aviation Administration.

107 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 108 and after July 1, 2016.
