HOUSE BILL NO. 977

- 1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-3-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 REQUIRE THE SALARY OF THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC 3 EDUCATION, AS ESTABLISHED BY THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION, TO BE
- APPROVED BY THE STATE PERSONNEL BOARD; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5
- SECTION 1. Section 37-3-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 37-3-9. (1) There shall be a State Superintendent of Public
- 9 Education who shall be appointed by the State Board of Education,
- 10 with the advice and consent of the Senate, and serve at the
- board's will and pleasure. He shall be the Chief Administrative 11
- 12 Officer for the State Department of Education and shall administer
- 13 the department in accordance with the policies established by the
- 14 State Board of Education. The * * * salary of the State
- Superintendent of Public Education shall be in an amount 15
- 16 established by the State Board of Education, subject to the
- 17 approval of the State Personnel Board. The State Superintendent
- 18 of Public Education shall have at least a master's degree in any

- 19 field and a minimum of five (5) years' experience in
- 20 administration in the educational field.
- 21 (2) The State Superintendent shall give bond in the penalty
- of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00), with sureties to be
- 23 approved by the Governor, conditioned according to law. The bond,
- 24 when approved, shall be filed and recorded in the Office of the
- 25 Secretary of State.
- 26 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 27 and after July 1, 2016.
