HOUSE BILL NO. 1124

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-27-29, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXPIRATION OF PERMITS ISSUED BY THE COMMISSION
ON MARINE RESOURCES FOR ACTIVITIES AFFECTING COASTAL WETLANDS; AND
FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. Section 49-27-29, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

- 8 49-27-29. In granting or modifying any permit, the
- 9 commission may impose conditions or limitations on the proposed
- 10 activity designed to carry out the public policy set forth in this
- 11 chapter. * * * Permits shall be valid for not more than five (5)
- 12 years from the date of issuance, except that permits for
- 13 maintenance dredging of existing channels maintained by a local
- 14 governmental entity shall be valid for not more than ten (10)
- 15 years. The commission may issue one (1) extension not to exceed
- 16 two (2) years in length if the applicant requests it in writing
- 17 before the expiration date of the permit.
- 18 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 19 and after July 1, 2016.
