HOUSE BILL NO. 1531

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO 2 DISCONTINUE USING THE STATEWIDE EDUCATOR EVALUATION PROCESS KNOWN AS THE "MISSISSIPPI STATEWIDE TEACHER APPRAISAL RUBRIC (M-STAR)"; TO REQUIRE EACH SCHOOL BOARD TO IMPLEMENT A TEACHER EVALUATION 5 SYSTEM FOR EDUCATORS EMPLOYED IN THE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT; TO 6 REQUIRE A SCHOOL DISTRICT TO OBTAIN APPROVAL OF ITS POLICY 7 ESTABLISHING AN EVALUATION SYSTEM FROM THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF 8 EDUCATION; TO REQUIRE THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PREPARE 9 A MODEL POLICY THAT MAY BE ADOPTED BY LOCAL SCHOOL BOARDS; AND FOR 10 RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 12 SECTION 1. (1) Beginning with the 2016-2017 school year, 13 the State Department of Education shall discontinue the use of the statewide educator evaluation process known as the "Mississippi 14 Statewide Teacher Appraisal Rubric (M-STAR)," and it shall be the 15 duty of the school board of each school district in the state to 16 17 adopt and implement a teacher evaluation system. (a) Beginning in the 2016-2017 school year, the school 18 (2)board of each local school district shall adopt and implement a 19 20 policy establishing an evaluation system designed to measure 21 teacher effectiveness for all licensed teachers employed in that

district. The evaluation system established under the policy must

- 23 be designed to promote continuous professional improvement in
- 24 instructional personnel in order to improve achievement at the
- 25 individual, school and district levels. In addition, the evaluation
- 26 system must include a process for monitoring and evaluating the
- 27 effective and consistent use of evaluation criteria by employees
- 28 having evaluation responsibilities and the overall effectiveness of
- 29 the evaluation system itself in improving instruction and student
- 30 learning.
- 31 (b) Before implementing an evaluation system
- 32 established under a policy pursuant to this subsection, the school
- 33 board shall submit the policy to the State Department of Education
- 34 for its approval of the evaluation system. If the department does
- 35 not approve the evaluation system, the policy must be returned to
- 36 the school board indicating the policy's deficiencies with
- 37 recommendations for correcting those deficiencies to the
- 38 satisfaction of the department.
- 39 (c) The State Department of Education shall prepare a
- 40 model policy establishing a teacher evaluation system which a
- 41 local school board, in its discretion, may adopt and follow.
- 42 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 43 and after July 1, 2016.
