HOUSE BILL NO. 1544

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A STATEWIDE SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING THE WILL OF THE CITIZENS OF THE STATE AS TO WHETHER OR NOT THE CONFEDERATE BATTLE EMBLEM SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE DESIGN OF THE OFFICIAL FLAG OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI; TO 5 SET THE DATE OF NOVEMBER 8, 2016, FOR THE STATEWIDE SPECIAL 6 ELECTION; TO REQUIRE THE ELECTION TO BE ADMINISTERED BY MEANS OF 7 BALLOTS WITH SPECIFIC LANGUAGE AND TO REQUIRE THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO PROVIDE SUCH BALLOTS TO THE ELECTION COMMISSIONERS OF 8 9 EACH COUNTY; TO ESTABLISH A COMMISSION TO REDESIGN THE MISSISSIPPI 10 STATE FLAG IN THE EVENT A MAJORITY OF THE ELECTORS VOTE IN FAVOR OF CHANGING THE FLAG; TO PRESCRIBE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE 11 12 COMMISSION AND TO PROVIDE FOR ITS ORGANIZATION AND MEETINGS; TO 13 PROVIDE THAT THE REDESIGNED MISSISSIPPI STATE FLAG ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION SHALL NOT INCLUDE THE DESIGN OF THE CONFEDERATE BATTLE 14 15 FLAG; TO PROVIDE THAT THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE COMMISSION SHALL 16 BE PRESENTED TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE LEGISLATURE BEFORE JANUARY 1, 17 2018; TO AMEND SECTIONS 23-15-351 AND 23-15-355, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 18 19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 20 **SECTION 1.** (1) There shall be a statewide special election 21 for the purpose of determining the will of the citizens of the 22 State of Mississippi as to whether or not the Confederate Battle emblem shall be removed from the Official Flag of the State of 23 24 Mississippi. The special election shall be held on Tuesday, 25 November 8, 2016, and shall be conducted in the same manner as regular general elections are held. The question put before the 26 H. B. - 27 voters at such statewide special election shall read on the
- 28 ballots as follows:
- 29 "PLEASE VOTE 'YES' OR 'NO'
- 30 The Confederate Battle Flag emblem shall be removed from the
- 31 Official State Flag.
- 32 'YES': ____"
- 33 The qualified electors may indicate their preference on the
- 34 line following the proposition that they prefer.
- 35 The preference of a majority of the qualified electors voting
- 36 in the election shall determine the design of the official flag of
- 37 the State of Mississippi. If a majority of the qualified electors
- 38 voting in the election vote "Yes," the provisions of Section 2 of
- 39 this act shall be in force and effect and the Commission to
- 40 Redesign the Mississippi State Flag shall develop a new design and
- 41 report to the Legislature to enact necessary legislation. If a
- 42 majority of the qualified electors voting in the election vote
- 43 "No," the design of the State Flag shall continue as prescribed in
- 44 Section 3-3-16.
- 45 (2) The statewide special election shall be administered by
- 46 means of ballots provided by the Secretary of State to the
- 47 election commissioners of each county. The Secretary of State
- 48 shall determine whether, in each county, it would be more
- 49 efficient to administer the election by paper ballots or voting
- 50 machines. The costs incurred in providing the ballots shall be
- 51 borne by the State of Mississippi subject to specific

- 52 appropriation therefor by the Legislature. All other costs 53 associated with the holding of the statewide special election
- 54 shall be borne by each individual county.
- 55 (3) The county election commissioners shall transmit to the
- 56 Secretary of State, in the same manner as the vote for state
- officers is transmitted, a statement of the total number of votes
- 58 cast for each proposition in the statewide special election. The
- 59 Secretary of State shall tabulate such returns and certify the
- 60 results to the Governor and to each house of the Legislature.
- 61 SECTION 2. (This section shall be in force and effect only
- in the event a majority of the qualified electors voting in the
- 63 election provided in Section 1 of this act vote in favor of
- 64 removing the Confederate Battle Flag emblem from the State Flag.)
- (1) There is established the Commission to Redesign the
- 66 Mississippi State Flag (commission) with the sole purpose of
- 67 developing, designing and reporting to the Governor and the
- 68 Legislature a new design for the Official Mississippi State Flag,
- 69 in order for the Legislature to adopt necessary legislation during
- 70 the 2018 Regular Session to effectuate the new design. The new
- 71 Mississippi State Flag adopted by the commission shall not include
- 72 the design of the Confederate Battle Flag. The commission is
- 73 charged with a sensitive and responsible task that it shall
- 74 conduct in an objective manner. The redesigned Mississippi State
- 75 Flag shall honor the past while embracing the promise of the
- 76 future.

7.7	(2)	The	Commission	to	Redesign	the	Mississippi	State	Flag

- 78 shall be appointed as follows:
- 79 (a) Three (3) members of the Mississippi House of
- 80 Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House;
- 81 (b) Three (3) members of the Mississippi Senate
- 82 appointed by the Lieutenant Governor;
- 83 (c) Eleven (11) members appointed by the Governor, to
- 84 include:
- (i) Two (2) high school students;
- 86 (ii) A Mississippi public schoolteacher and a
- 87 Mississippi public university instructor;
- 88 (iii) A representative from the Mississippi
- 89 Economic Council;
- 90 (iv) A representative from the Mississippi Arts
- 91 Commission:
- 92 (v) Two (2) representatives from the Board of
- 93 Trustees of the Mississippi Department of Archives and History;
- 94 (vi) A representative from business and industry;
- 95 and
- 96 (vii) Two (2) members from the state at large.
- 97 All appointments shall be made within thirty (30) days
- 98 following the date of the referendum provided in Section 1 of this
- 99 act. The chairman of the commission shall be appointed by the
- 100 Governor from the members of the commission. The commission shall
- 101 meet as soon as practicable after appointments have been made upon

- 102 the call of the chairman, and shall organize for business. A
- 103 quorum of the appointed membership of the commission shall be
- 104 required for the adoption of any reports and recommendations. The
- 105 Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall provide
- 106 meeting space and clerical support for the operation of the
- 107 commission.
- 108 (3) The Commission to Redesign the Mississippi State Flag
- 109 shall have the following functions and duties:
- 110 (a) To hold regular, public meetings when and where it
- 111 sees fit;
- 112 (b) To receive written, public comment, in a manner it
- 113 sees fit, and to hold public hearings, under the terms and
- 114 conditions it determines and sees fit;
- 115 (c) To collect, examine and consider all information
- 116 which it determines may be helpful in making a recommendation on
- 117 use and adoption of Mississippi's State Flag;
- 118 (d) To consult with historical experts, social science
- 119 experts, representatives of organizations and associations, and
- 120 others, as it sees fit, whose knowledge or expertise may assist
- 121 the commission in making its recommendation;
- 122 (e) To make any inquiries and conduct any business that
- 123 may assist the commission in submitting a design for a State Flag;
- 124 however, the new Mississippi State Flag adopted by the commission
- 125 shall not include the design of the Confederate Battle Flag;

126		(f)	Keep	minutes	of	its	meetings,	and	make	those
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- 128 (g) To make a written recommendation for a new design 129 for the Official Mississippi State Flag and an oral presentation 130 if requested, to the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor and the 131 Speaker of the House on or before January 1, 2018.
- 132 (4) Members of the commission shall receive no compensation 133 for service on the commission but may receive reasonable 134 reimbursement for actual expenses to the extent funds are 135 available for that purpose.
- 136 (5) The State Flag currently in use shall remain in use
 137 until such time as the Mississippi Legislature considers the
 138 report of the commission and the Legislature has had ample time to
 139 act.
- SECTION 3. Section 23-15-351, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:
- 142 23-15-351. It shall be the duty of the chairman of the election commission of each county to have printed all necessary 143 144 ballots for use in elections, except ballots in municipal 145 elections which shall be printed as herein provided by the 146 authorities of the respective municipalities; and the said 147 election commissioner shall cause the official ballot to be printed by a printer sworn to keep the ballots secret under the 148 penalties prescribed by law. The printer shall deliver to the 149 election commissioners for holding elections, a certificate of the 150

151	number of ballots printed for each precinct, and shall not print
152	any additional ballots, except on instruction of proper election
153	commissioners; and failure to observe either of these requirements

154 shall be a misdemeanor.

In the case of the statewide special election for the selection of the official State Flag provided for in Section 1 of Laws, 2001, Chapter 301, the provisions of this article regarding the printing and distribution of the official ballots shall be governed by the provisions of Section 1(2) of Laws, 2001, Chapter 301.

In the case of the statewide special election regarding the

design of the Official State Flag provided for in Section 1 of

this act, the provisions of this article regarding the printing

and distribution of the official ballots shall be governed by the

provisions of Section 1(2) of this act.

SECTION 4. Section 23-15-355, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:

23-15-355. Ballots in all elections shall be printed and distributed at public expense and shall be known as "official ballots." The expense of printing such ballots shall be paid out of the county treasury, except that in municipal elections such expenses shall be paid by the respective cities, towns and villages. In the case of the statewide special election for the selection of the Official State Flag provided for in Section 1 of Laws, 2001, Chapter 301, the provisions of this section regarding

178	301. In the case of the statewide special election regarding the
179	design of the Official State Flag provided for in Section 1 of
180	this act, the provisions of this section regarding payment of the

182	provisions of Section 1(2) of this act.
183	SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2016.

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
