HOUSE BILL NO. 1547

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3-3-16, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO  
2 CHANGE THE DESIGN OF THE OFFICIAL FLAG OF THE STATE OF  
3 MISSISSIPPI; TO PROHIBIT THE PREVIOUS OFFICIAL STATE FLAG FROM  
4 BEING FLOWN OR DISPLAYED ON OR IN ANY PUBLIC BUILDING OR OTHER  
5 PUBLIC PROPERTY, EXCEPT IN A HISTORICAL EXHIBIT IN A PUBLIC  
6 MUSEUM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 **SECTION 1.** Section 3-3-16, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
9 amended as follows:

10 3-3-16. The official flag of the State of Mississippi shall  
11 have the following design: \* \* \* with width two-thirds (2/3) of  
12 its length; the union (canton) to be square, bordered with white  
13 on the fly side and the bottom side, in width two-thirds (2/3) the  
14 width of the flag, the ground of the union to be old glory blue,  
15 and emblazoned with an outer circle of thirteen (13) five-pointed  
16 stars, an inner circle of six (6) five-pointed stars and a single  
17 large five-pointed star in the center; the stars in the inner and  
18 outer circle to be one-twelfth (1/12) the width of the flag, and  
19 the center star to be one-eighth (1/8) the width of the flag, with  
20 all stars to be pointed upward; the field to be divided into three



21 (3) bars of equal width, the upper one old glory blue, the center  
22 one white and the lower one old glory red. The nineteen (19)  
23 stars surrounding the center star represent the first nineteen  
24 (19) states admitted to the United States. The center star  
25 represents the State of Mississippi and symbolizes that  
26 Mississippi was the twentieth state admitted to the United States.

27 **SECTION 2.** (1) The flag that was the official flag of the  
28 State of Mississippi immediately before July 1, 2016, as described  
29 in subsection (2) of this section, may not be flown or displayed  
30 on or in any public building or other public property, except in a  
31 historical exhibit in a public museum. The appropriate public  
32 agency or public official having jurisdiction over a public  
33 building or public property shall enforce the provisions of this  
34 section.

35 (2) The flag that was the official flag of the State of  
36 Mississippi before July 1, 2016, had the following design: with  
37 width two-thirds (2/3) of its length; with the union (canton) to  
38 be square, in width two-thirds (2/3) of the width of the flag; the  
39 ground of the union to be red and a broad blue saltire thereon,  
40 bordered with white and emblazoned with thirteen (13) mullets or  
41 five-pointed stars, corresponding with the number of the original  
42 States of the Union; the field to be divided into three (3) bars  
43 of equal width, the upper one blue, the center one white, and the  
44 lower one, extending the whole length of the flag, red (the  
45 national colors).



46           **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
47 and after July 1, 2016.
