HOUSE BILL NO. 1548

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3-3-16, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO

2 CHANGE THE DESIGN OF THE OFFICIAL FLAG OF THE STATE OF 3 MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** Section 3-3-16, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 3-3-16. The official flag of the State of Mississippi shall 7 have the following design: * * * The width is two-thirds (2/3) of 8 9 its length; the field is white, with a single large five-pointed 10 star in the center; the large star is surrounded with circle of 11 nineteen (19) small five-pointed stars; all of the stars are dark blue; and a vertical red bar is on the inner and outer edges of 12 the flag, with each bar being one-fifth (1/5) the length of the 13 14 flag. The small stars represent the first nineteen (19) states admitted to the United States, and the center star represents the 15 State of Mississippi as the twentieth state to join the Union. 16 The small stars form a circle, a shape that represents wholeness, 17

unity and potential. The red bars stand opposite of one another,

- 19 recognizing the passionate differences that the people of our
- 20 state sometimes harbor. Joining all of the elements is a field of
- 21 white symbolizing illumination, spirituality, brightness and
- 22 promise.
- 23 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 24 and after July 1, 2016.
