## HOUSE BILL NO. 1552

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A COMMISSION TO REDESIGN THE MISSISSIPPI STATE FLAG; TO PRESCRIBE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION AND TO PROVIDE FOR ITS ORGANIZATION AND MEETINGS; TO PROVIDE THAT THE COMMISSION SHALL DEVELOP TWO OPTIONS FOR A NEW DESIGN OF THE 5 MISSISSIPPI STATE FLAG; TO PROVIDE THAT THE LEGISLATURE SHALL 6 DETERMINE WHICH OF THE TWO OPTIONS SHALL BE THE NEW MISSISSIPPI STATE FLAG DURING THE 2017 SESSION; TO PROVIDE THAT THE TWO 7 OPTIONS FOR A NEW MISSISSIPPI STATE FLAG ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION 8 9 SHALL NOT INCLUDE THE DESIGN OF THE CONFEDERATE BATTLE FLAG; TO 10 PROVIDE THAT THE NEW MISSISSIPPI STATE FLAG SHALL BE UNVEILED AT 11 CEREMONIES ON THE BICENTENNIAL OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI ON 12 DECEMBER 10, 2017; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 14 **SECTION 1.** (1) There is established the Commission to Redesign the Mississippi State Flag (commission) with the sole 15 16 purpose of developing, designing and reporting to the Governor and the Legislature two (2) options for a new design for the official 17 18 Mississippi State Flag on or before December 10, 2016. The Legislature shall determine which of the two (2) options shall be 19 the new Mississippi State Flag during the 2017 Regular Session. 20 21 The new Mississippi State Flag shall be unveiled at appropriate ceremonies on the State's Bicentennial Celebration on December 10, 22 23 2017. The two (2) options for a new Mississippi State Flag that H. B. No. 1552 ~ OFFICIAL ~ G1/2

- 24 are adopted by the commission shall not include the design of the
- 25 Confederate Battle Flag. The commission is charged with a
- 26 sensitive and responsible task that it shall conduct in an
- 27 objective manner. The two (2) options for a new Mississippi State
- 28 Flag shall honor the past while embracing the promise of the
- 29 future.
- 30 (2) The Commission to Redesign the Mississippi State Flag
- 31 shall be appointed as follows:
- 32 (a) Three (3) members of the Mississippi House of
- 33 Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House;
- 34 (b) Three (3) members of the Mississippi Senate
- 35 appointed by the Lieutenant Governor;
- 36 (c) Eleven (11) members appointed by the Governor, to
- 37 include:
- 38 (i) Two (2) high school students;
- 39 (ii) A Mississippi public schoolteacher and a
- 40 Mississippi public university instructor;
- 41 (iii) A representative from the Mississippi
- 42 Economic Council;
- 43 (iv) A representative from the Mississippi Arts
- 44 Commission;
- 45 (v) Two (2) representatives from the Board of
- 46 Trustees of the Mississippi Department of Archives and History;
- 47 (vi) A representative from business and industry;
- 48 and

49	(vii	) Two	(2)	members	from	the	state	at	large.
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- All appointments shall be made by July 1, 2016. The chairman
- of the commission shall be appointed by the Governor from the
- 52 members of the commission. The commission shall meet as soon as
- 53 practicable after appointments have been made upon the call of the
- 54 chairman, and shall organize for business. A quorum of the
- 55 appointed membership of the commission shall be required for the
- 56 adoption of any reports and recommendations. The Mississippi
- 57 Department of Archives and History shall provide meeting space and
- 58 clerical support for the operation of the commission.
- 59 (3) The Commission to Redesign the Mississippi State Flag
- 60 shall have the following functions and duties:
- 61 (a) To hold regular, public meetings when and where it
- 62 sees fit;
- (b) To receive written, public comment, in a manner it
- 64 sees fit, and to hold public hearings, under the terms and
- 65 conditions it determines and sees fit;
- 66 (c) To collect, examine and consider all information
- 67 which it determines may be helpful in making a recommendation on
- 68 use and adoption of Mississippi's state flag;
- 69 (d) To consult with historical experts, social science
- 70 experts, representatives of organizations and associations, and
- 71 others, as it sees fit, whose knowledge or expertise may assist
- 72 the commission in making its recommendation;

- 73 (e) To make any inquiries and conduct any business that
- 74 may assist the commission in submitting a design for a state flag;
- 75 however, the two (2) options for a new Mississippi State Flag
- 76 adopted by the commission shall not include the design of the
- 77 Confederate Battle Flag;
- 78 (f) Keep minutes of its meetings, and make those
- 79 minutes available to the public; and
- 80 (g) To make a written recommendation for two (2)
- 81 options for a new Mississippi State Flag, and an oral presentation
- 82 if requested, to the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor and the
- 83 Speaker of the House on or before January 1, 2017.
- 84 (4) Members of the commission shall receive no compensation
- 85 for service on the commission but may receive reasonable
- 86 reimbursement for actual expenses to the extent funds are
- 87 available for that purpose.
- 88 (5) The state flag currently in use shall remain in use
- 89 until such time as the Mississippi Legislature considers the
- 90 report of the commission and the Legislature has had ample time to
- 91 act.
- 92 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 93 and after July 1, 2016.
