HOUSE BILL NO. 1634

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING 2 SALARIES AND TRAVEL EXPENSES OF DISTRICT ATTORNEYS AND ASSISTANT 3 DISTRICT ATTORNEYS OF THE STATE AND PAYING OFFICE EXPENSES OF 4 DISTRICT ATTORNEYS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2017. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 7 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying 8 9 salaries and travel expenses of district attorneys, assistant 10 district attorneys, criminal investigators, tort claims assessments, and paying office expenses of district attorneys for 11 12 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017..\$ 19,771,040.00. 13 14 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 15 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Prosecutor Compensation Fund, referred to in Section 99-19-73, 16 17 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of paying salaries of assistant district attorneys of the state as authorized in Section 18

 25-31-5(1) for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, and ending

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 June 30, 2017.....\$ 5,711,650.00.

21 SECTION 3. None of the funds authorized in this section 22 shall be used to reimburse district attorneys or their staff for 23 taxable meals incurred within their geographical district.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated herein, office expenses
of district attorneys as authorized by Section 25-31-8,
Mississippi Code of 1972, in the amount of One Million Two Hundred
Thirty-four Thousand Dollars (\$1,234,000.00).

SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, office expenses and such funds for salaries shall be provided as authorized in Section 25-3-35(6), Mississippi Code of 1972, to fund the salary for one (1) full-time legal assistant in the Sixth Circuit Court District as authorized in Section 25-31-5(2)(f), Mississippi Code of 1972.

34 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 35 district attorneys and assistant district attorneys of the state shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related 36 37 to the expenditure of all funds appropriated in this act and that those records shall be in the same format and level of details as 38 39 maintained for Fiscal Year 2016. It is further the intention of 40 the Legislature that the budget requests for Fiscal Year 2018 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a 41 42 format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2017 budget request process 43

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44 for each agency and institution appropriated funds within the 45 provisions of this act.

46 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that with 47 the funds provided herein, the district attorneys shall submit 48 their Five-Year Strategic Plan(s) as required in Section 49 27-103-129(1), Mississippi Code of 1972.

50 SECTION 8. The amount of funds appropriated from the State 51 General Fund in this bill are conditioned upon the availability 52 for appropriation of the full amount of the state general funds 53 that were projected in the general fund revenue estimate for 54 fiscal year 2017 that was determined under the provision of 55 Section 27-103-125.

56 If the amount of general funds projected to be available for appropriation for fiscal year 2017 would be reduced by the 57 enactment into law of any revenue bills, as defined in Joint Rule 58 59 40, that have been passed by the House of Representatives by March 60 17, 2016, then the amount of funds appropriated from the State General Fund in this bill shall be reduced by the same percentage 61 62 reduction in the amount of general funds that would be available 63 for appropriation for fiscal year 2017, and the reduced amount 64 shall be engrossed into this bill before it is transmitted to 65 Senate.

The determination of whether the House has passed any such revenue bills by March 17, 2016, and the amount and percentage of the resulting reduction in the amount of general funds projected

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69 to be available for appropriation for fiscal year 2017, shall be 70 determined by the Legislative Budget Office and certified in 71 writing to the Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee by 72 the Director of the Legislative Budget Office.

73 SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 74 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 75 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 76 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 77 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 78 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 79 SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2016; and shall stand repealed from and after 80 June 30, 2016. 81
